



Safety and Infection Control at Bright Horizons University City

1. Upon entering the center before the second entrance to the lobby health checks are being completed. Temperatures of families, staff and children are taken. They are required to answer a series of questions about their well being. Temperatures taken that are 100.4 the family is not allowed to enter the center and need to leave.
2. Upon entering the lobby a teacher or administration will take the child to their classroom. Parents are not permitted into the classroom areas at this time.
3. There are sanitizing wipes at the kiosk stations for signing their child in for the day. They must sanitize the kiosk after each use. There are hand sanitizers outside every classroom at the entrance and in the lobby.
4. All faculty are wearing masks daily.
5. All teachers are in their designated age components and are not rotated to other age groups to cover ratios. To minimize risk all teachers are in permanent assignments at this time. Administration is to remain in their office spaces.
6. The common areas are not in use at this time. Our movement area, STEM Lab and art studio are temporarily not in use. They can do these things in the classroom for now.
7. Playground is in use. A class goes out for 30-45 minutes. The next group goes out 45 minutes after that. Ex 10-10:45 Toddlers then 11:30-12:15 preschool.
8. Laundering of sheets soft items daily.
9. Sanitizing toys daily.
10. Common areas and door handles, hard surfaces are sanitized at 10, and 2pm And 5pm
Classrooms are sanitized continually throughout the day.
11. Any conversation that may need to take place is done 6ft apart or by phone.
12. Any center visits are done via Face Time as scheduling allows.
13. 3 teachers are permitted in the lounge at one time and there is assigned seating so they are 6ft apart. They sanitize their space before they eat and after.
14. 2 teachers are permitted with assigned seating 6ft apart to eat in our learning resource center at this time.
15. Hand-washing is continual throughout the day. Teachers and children wash their hands when entering the classroom and when leaving at the end of the day. Hand washing is done after diaper changes, meals, outdoor play and at other intervals.
16. Our monthly evacuation drills are being conducted by age group so that there is not a large group together all at once.
17. No external trainers are coming into the center at this time. Teachers are being given training modules to complete online with follow up assignments.
18. Family style dining is not taking place at this time. All snacks have to be individually packaged.
19. No events are occurring as well.
