2003 Benchmark Data*-- Gender Statistics of Faculty University of Pennsylvania School of Medicine

The following graphs and charts depict the status of women faculty at the University of Pennsylvania School of Medicine. It has been well documented nationally that, relative to their male colleagues in academic medicine, women are over-represented in the junior ranks and are less likely to attain promotion or tenure.

In fact, data from the Association of American Medical Colleges (AAMC) indicate that the proportion of men and women across academic ranks has not changed substantially in over twenty years. Since 1996, in order to increase awareness of this gender discrepancy, the AAMC has annually compiled and reported institutional benchmark statistics regarding women in academic medicine from 94% of U.S. medical schools. FOCUS on Health & Leadership for Women has compiled benchmark data from the University of Pennsylvania School of Medicine since 1999.

This report consists of data for the year ending 12/31/03 from the gender and minority report supplied by the Office of Faculty Affairs in the School of Medicine at the University of Pennsylvania. These statistics were then compared with national benchmarks published by the AAMC in their 2002-2003 annual report, *Women in U.S. Academic Medicine-- Statistics*.

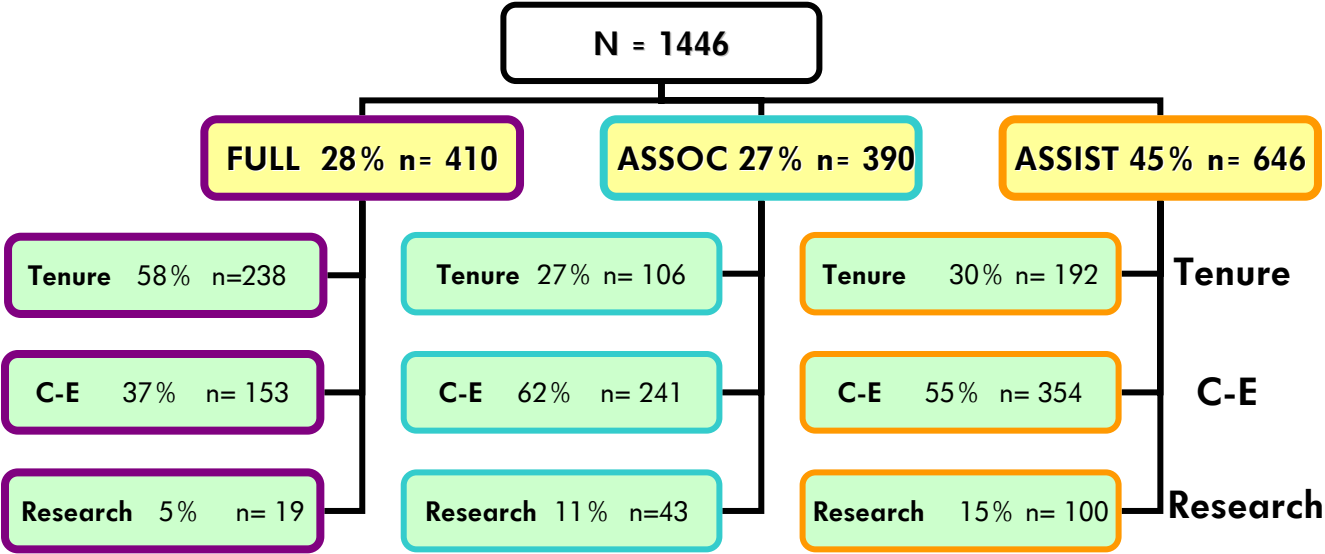

Gender Distribution within Ranks by Department

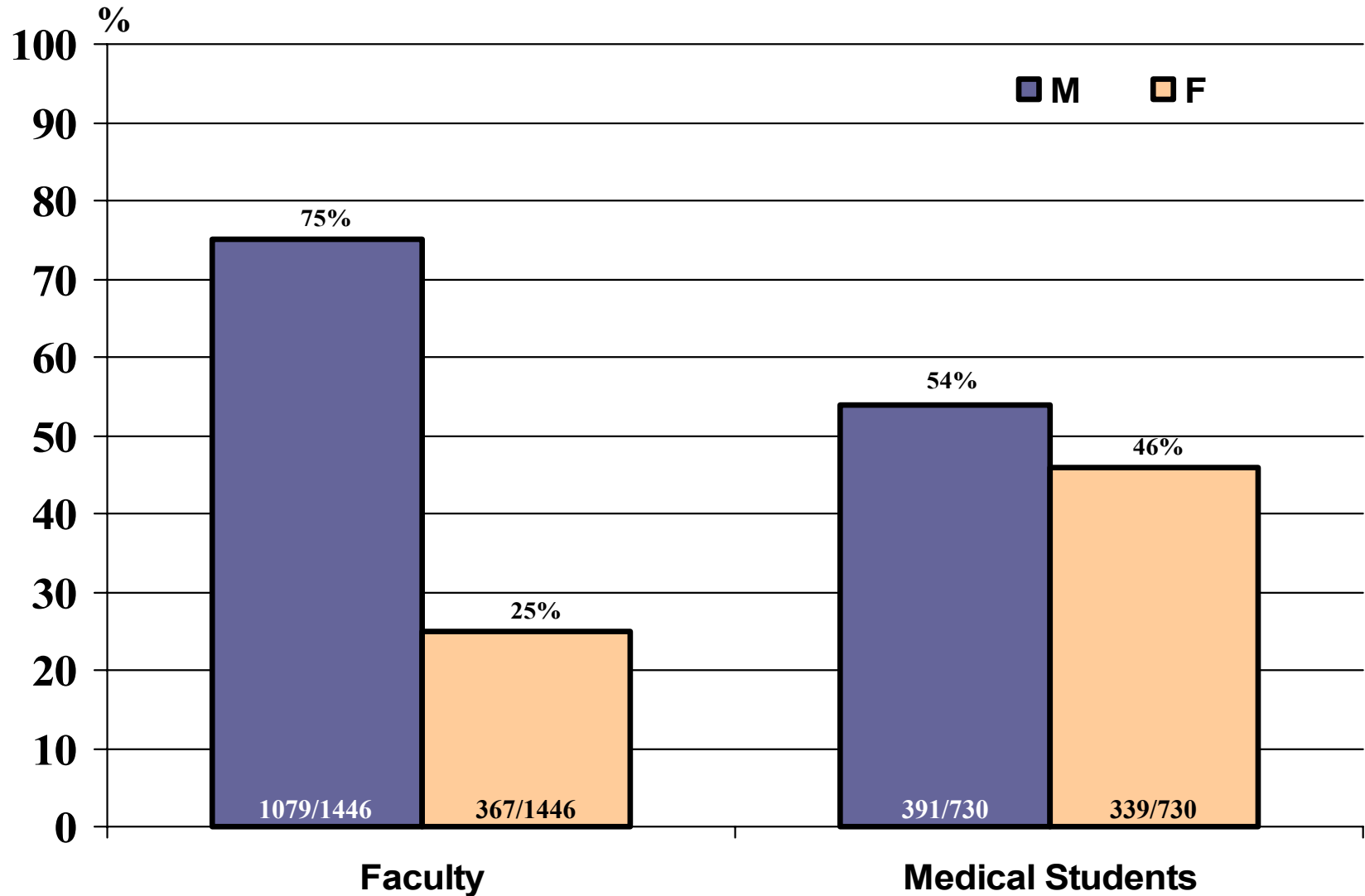

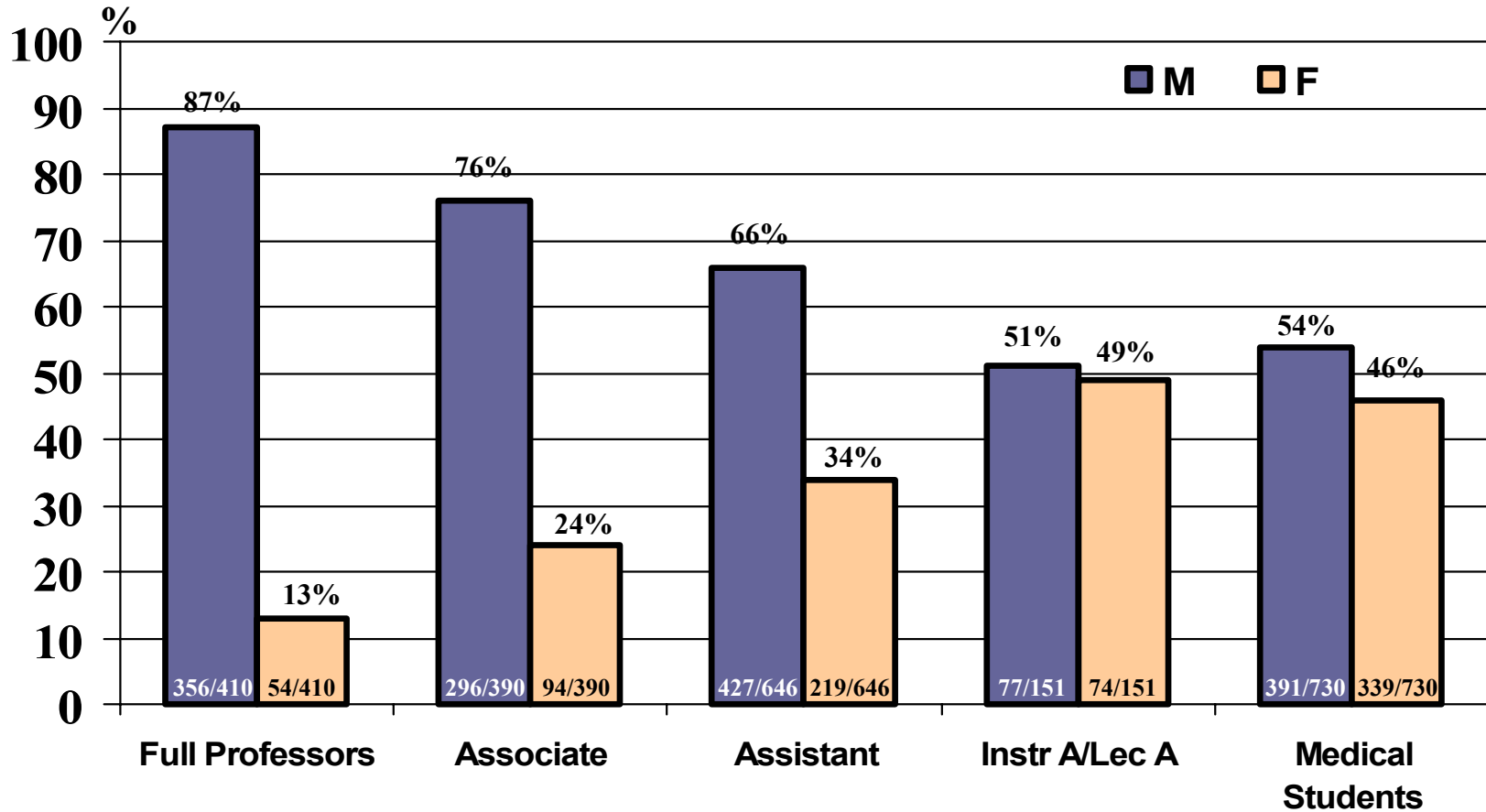

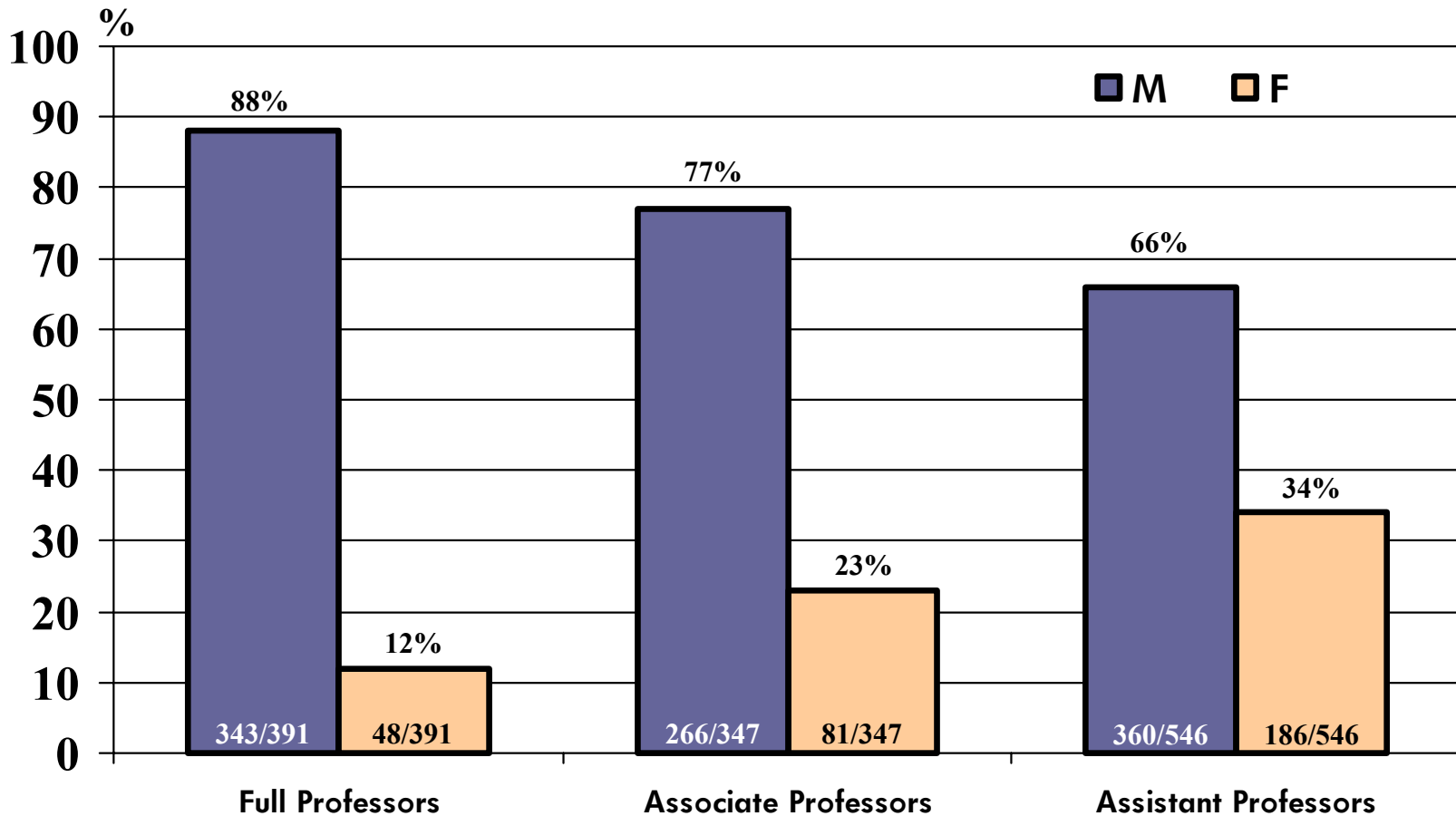

Penn Medical School *Standing** Faculty, 12/31/03

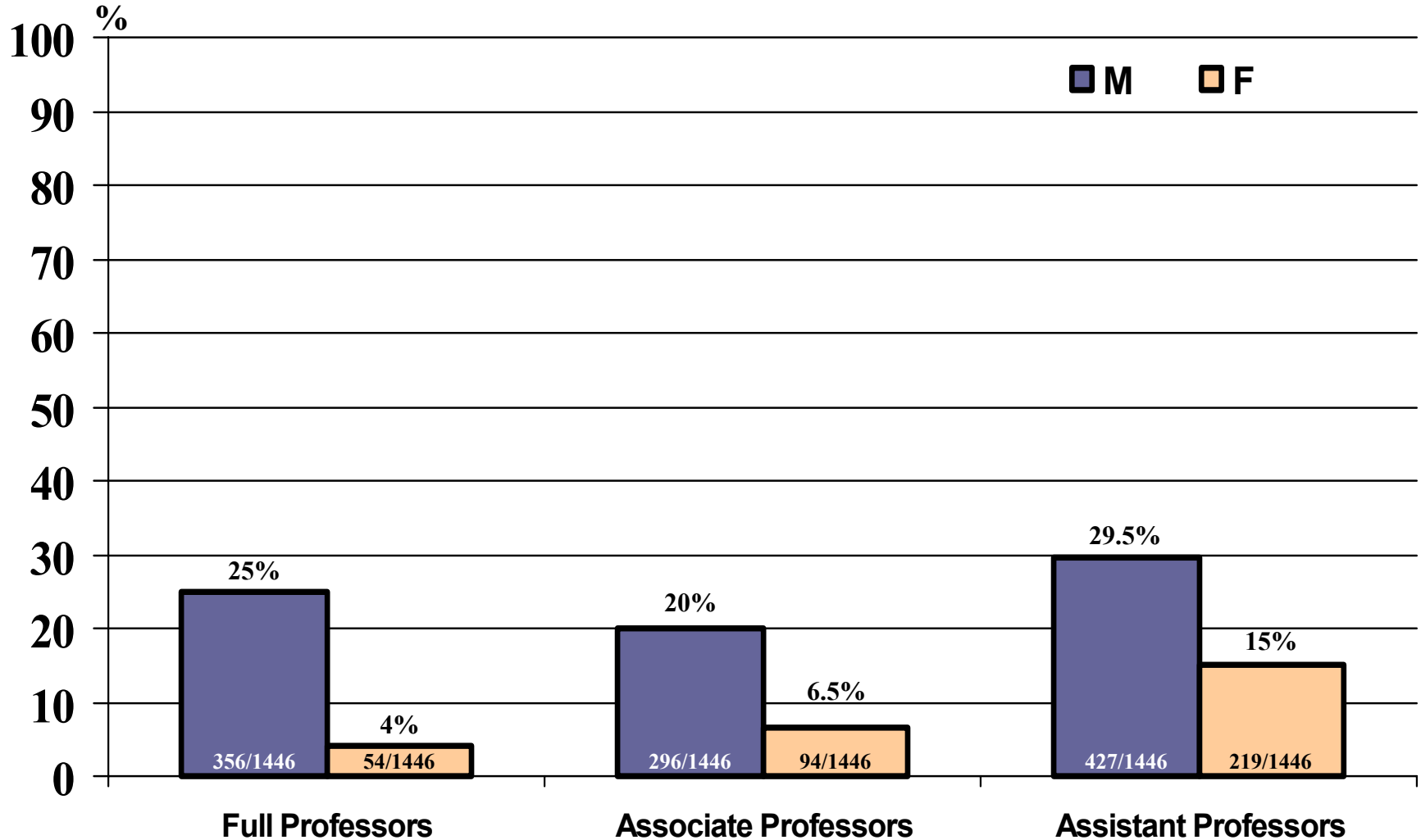

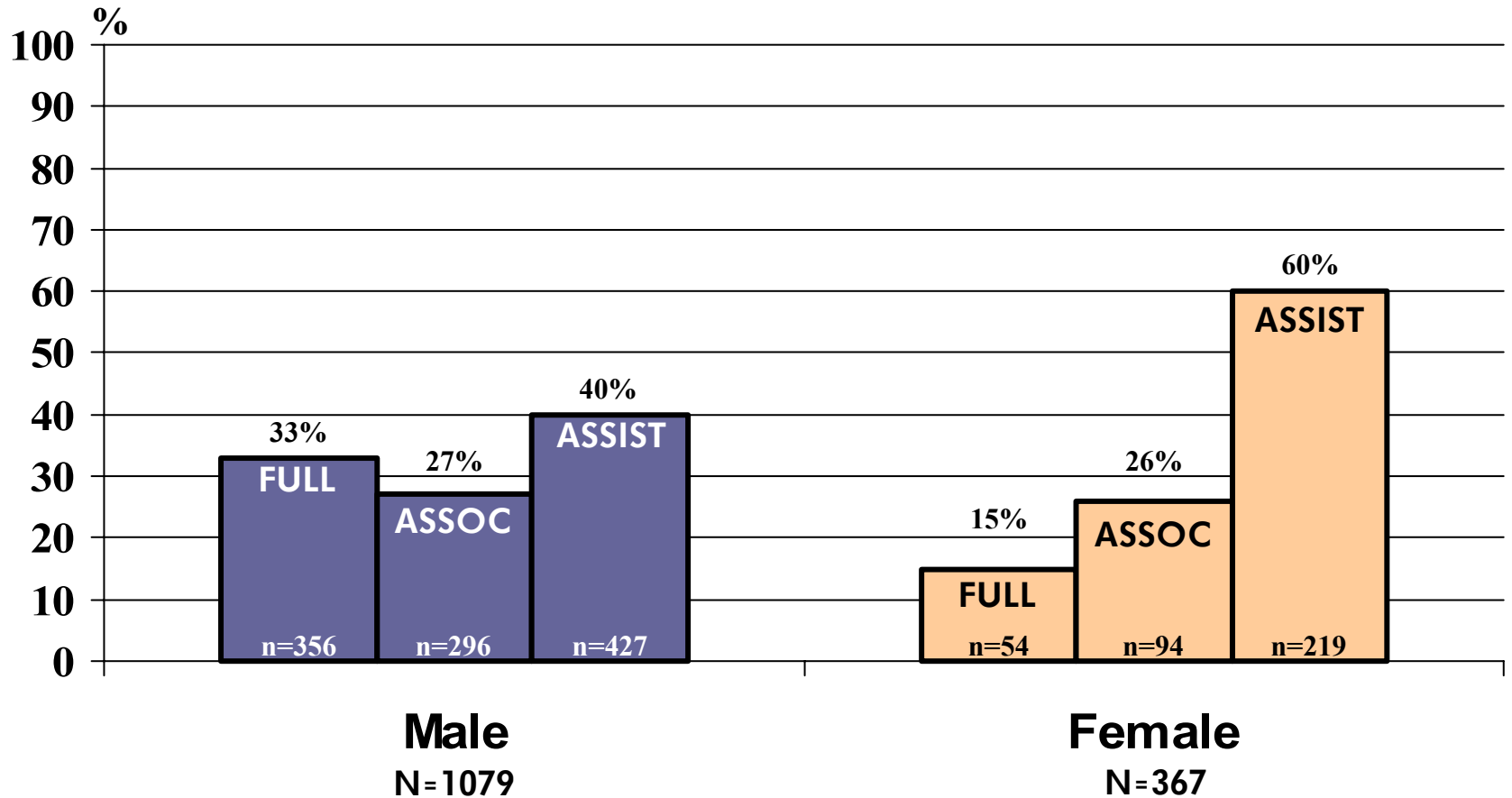

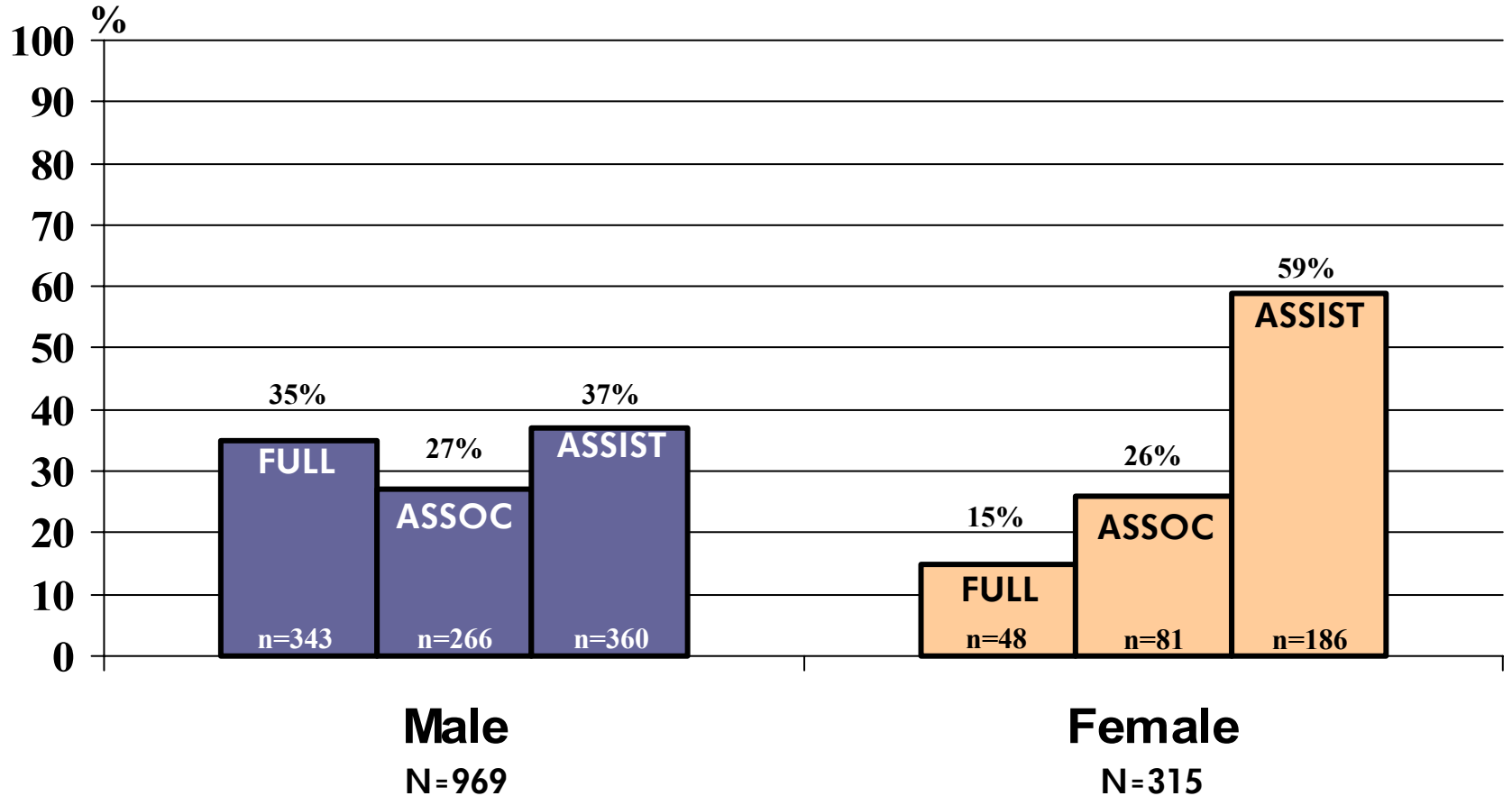

Distribution of Ranks Separated by Gender

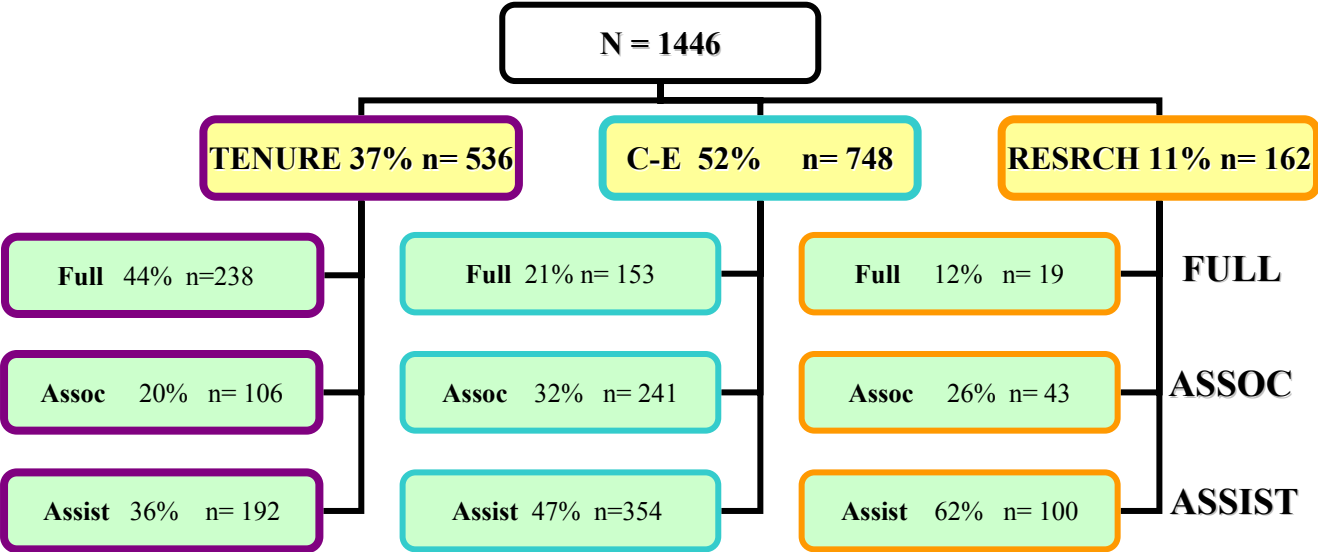

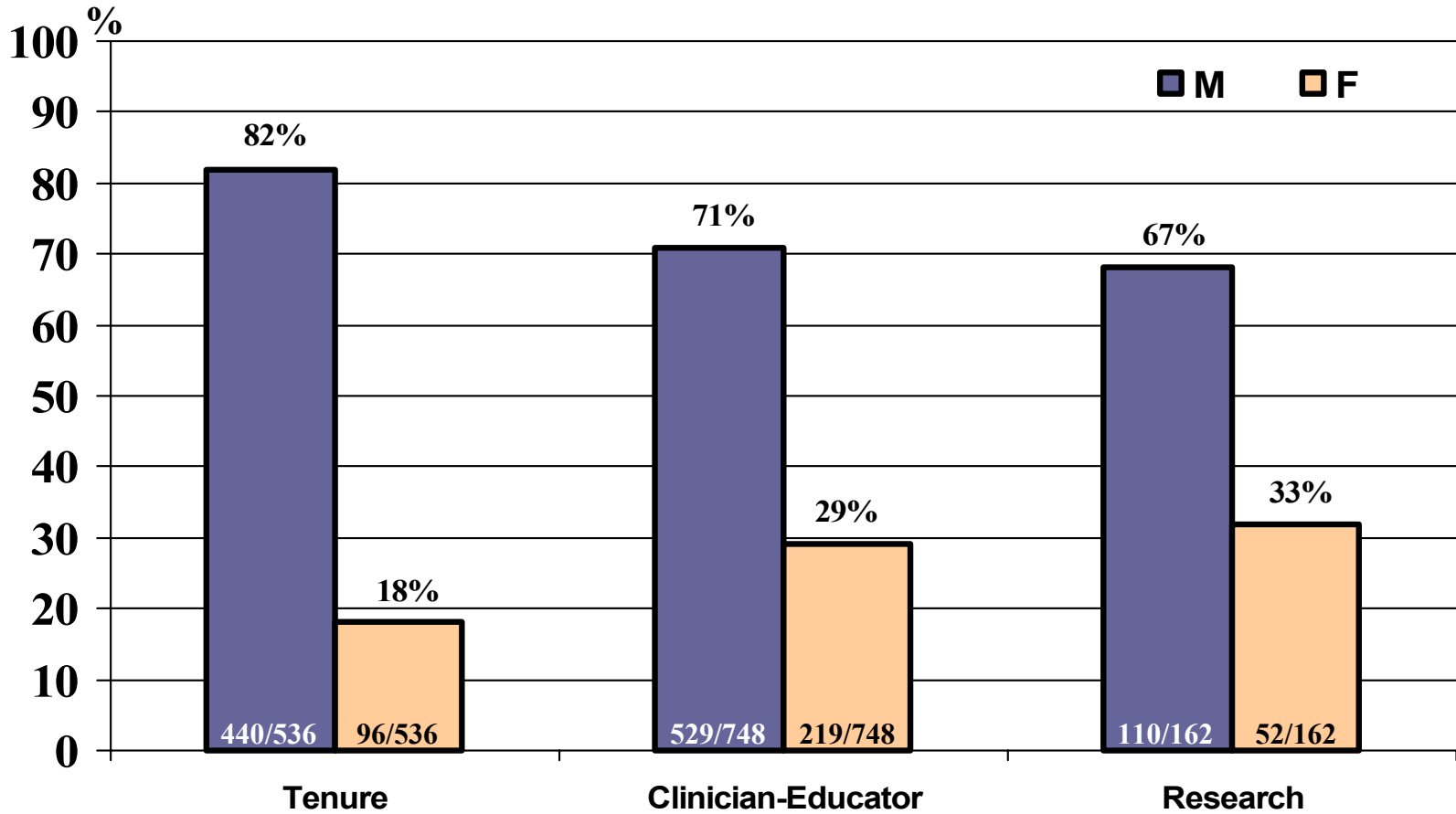

Gender Distribution within Tracks by Department University of Pennsylvania Medical School Faculty, 12/31/03

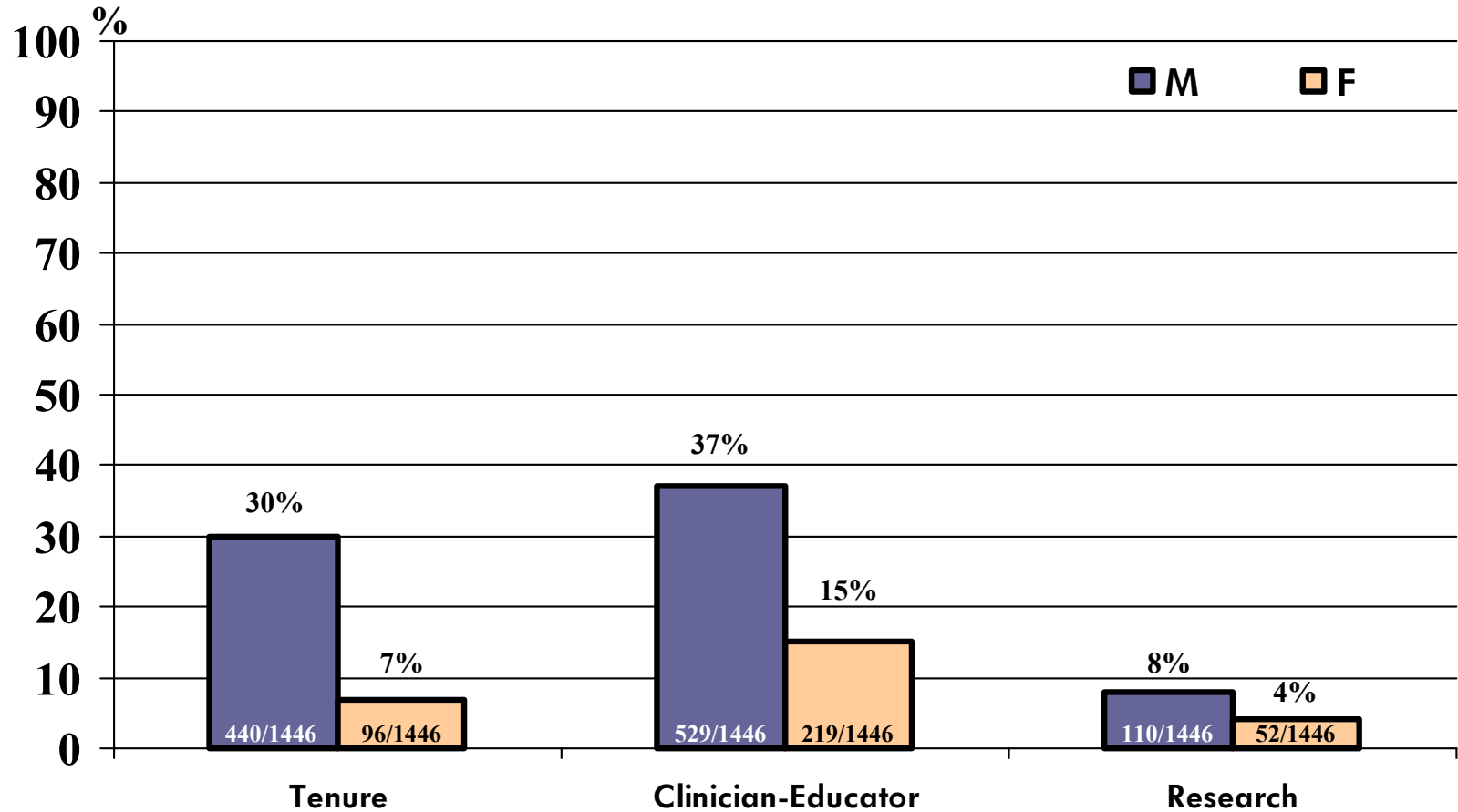

Gender Distribution within Tracks Penn Medical School Fulltime Faculty, 12/31/03



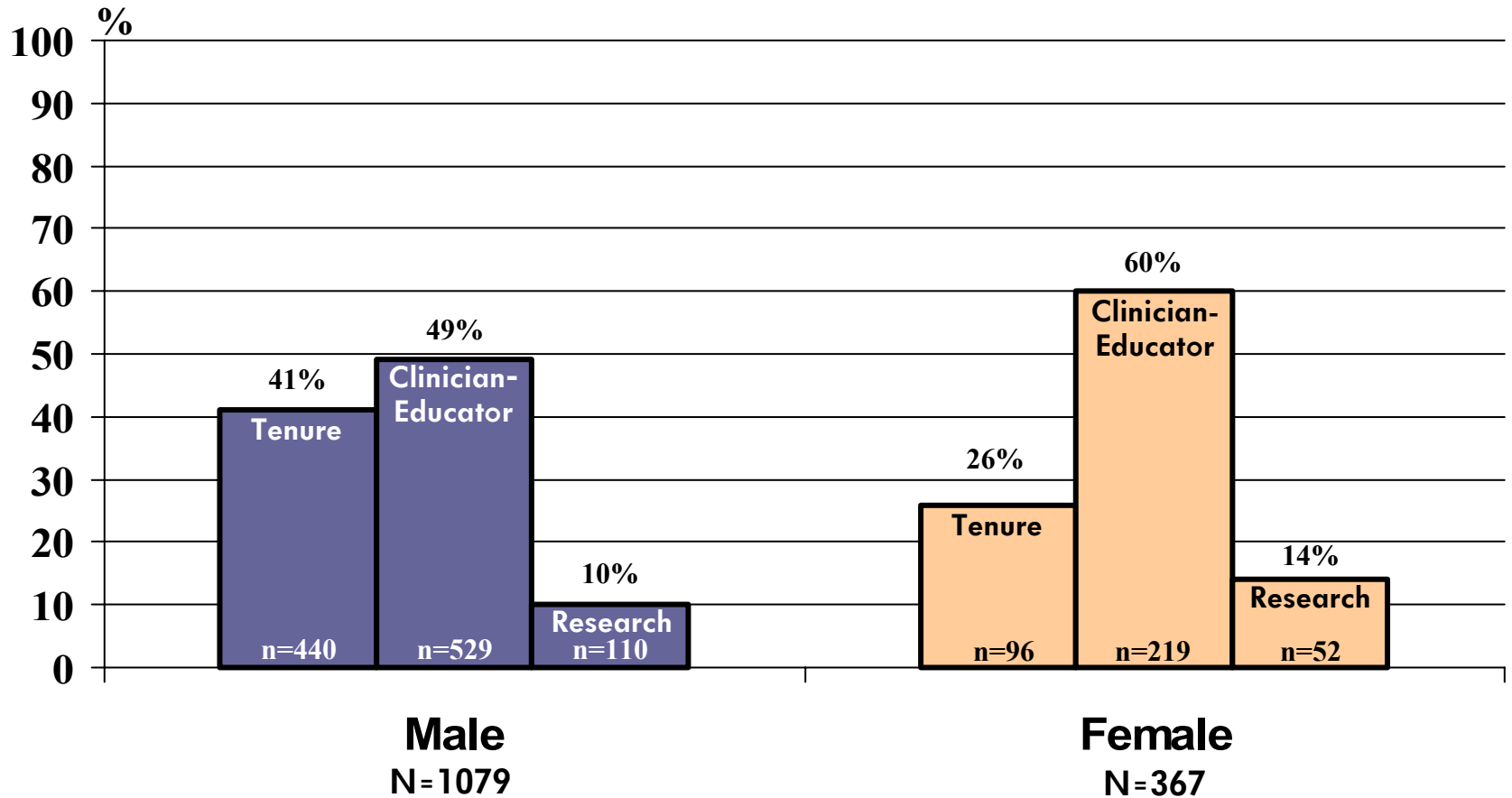
Gender Breakdown across Tracks

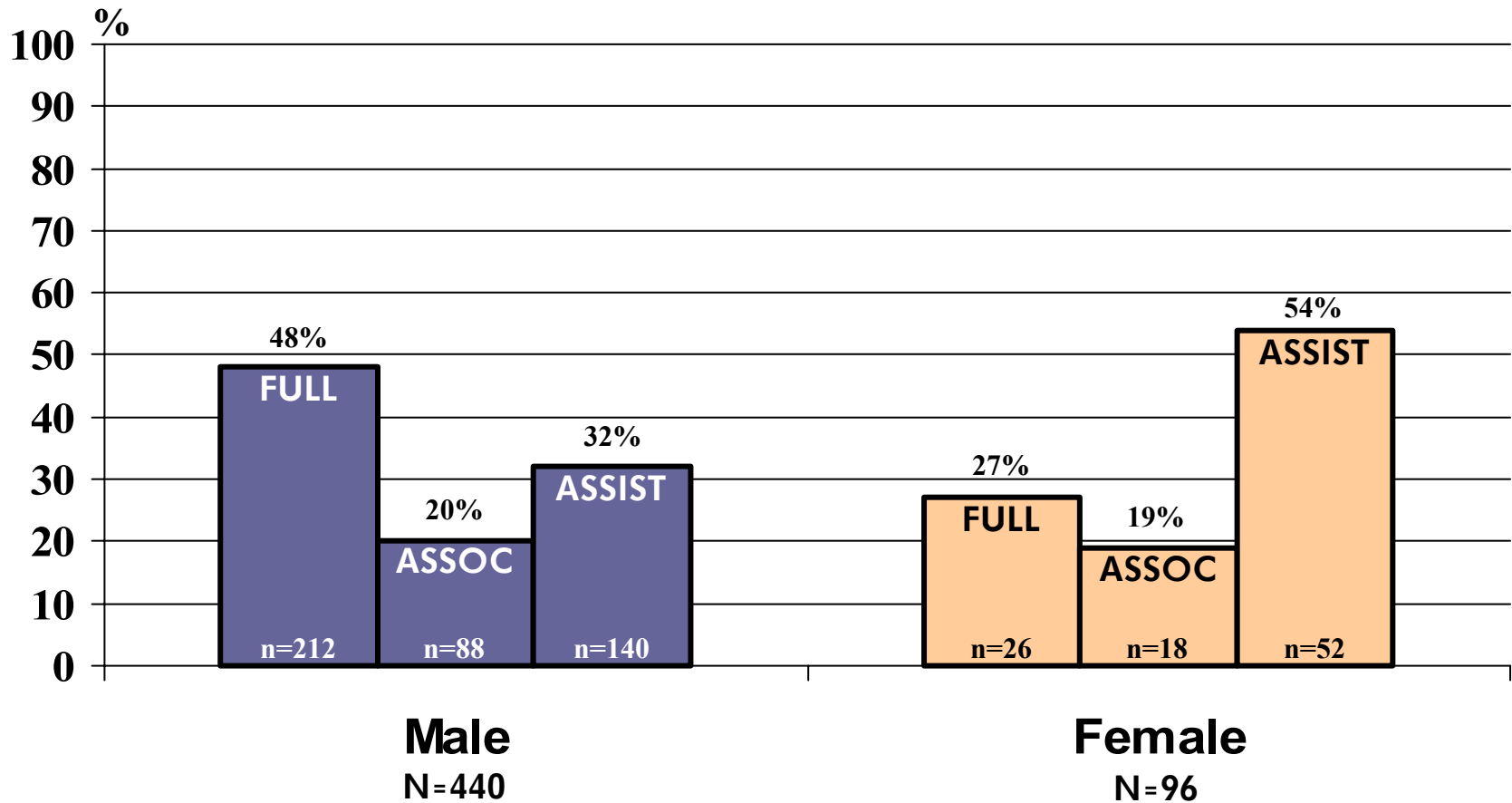

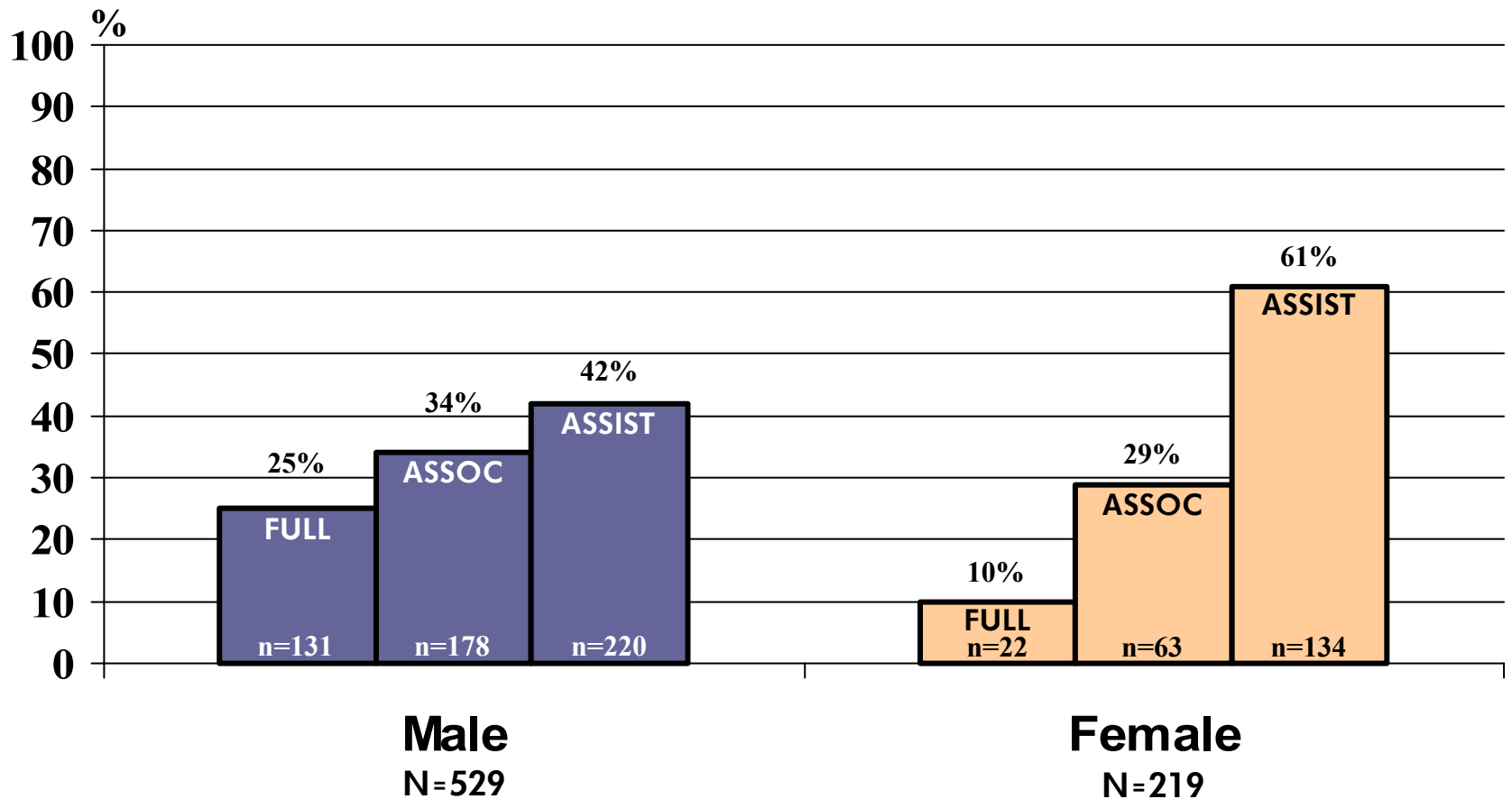
Distribution of Tracks Separated by Gender Penn Medical School Fulltime Faculty, 12/31/03



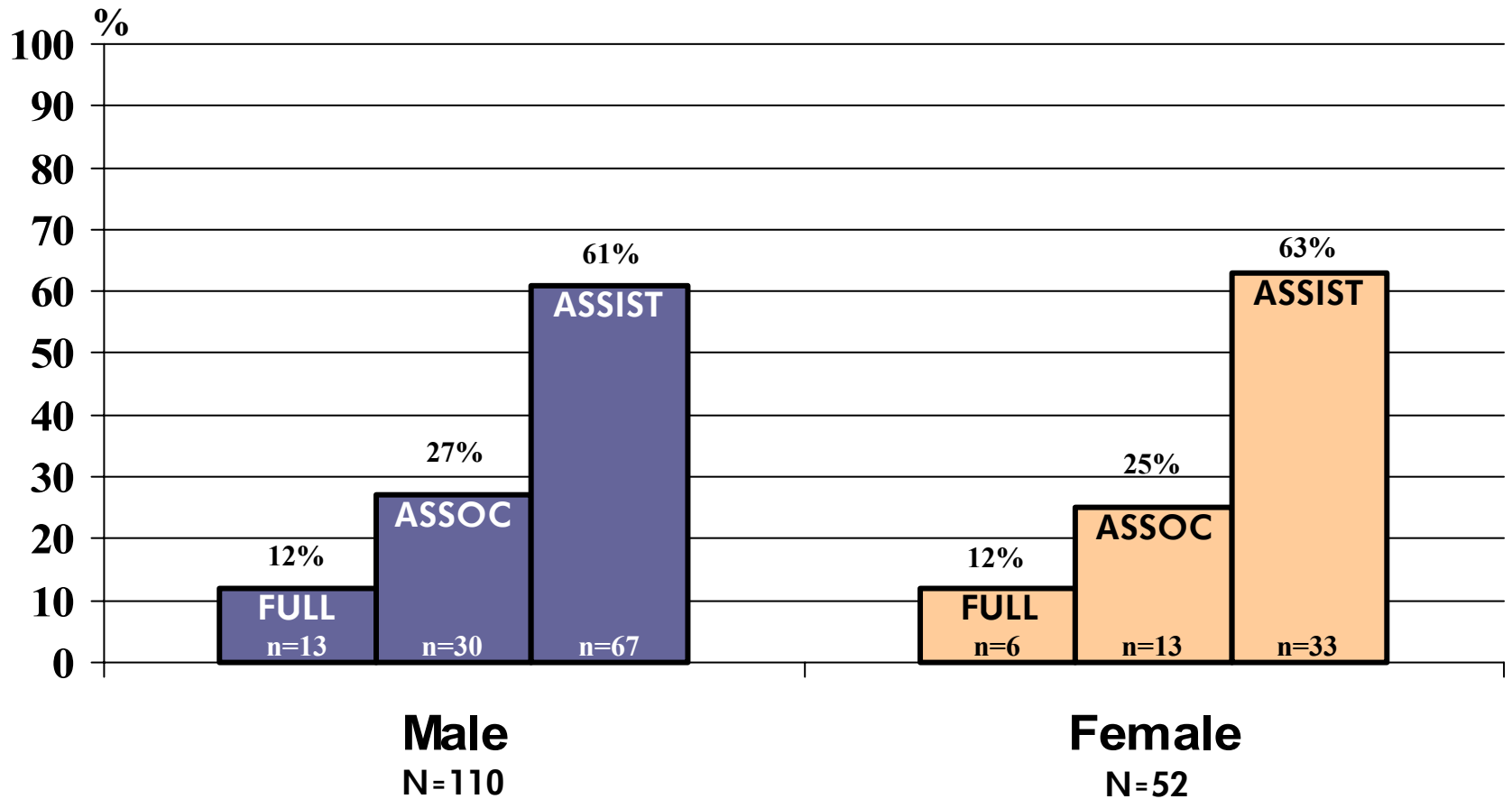
Rank Distribution of *Tenure* Track, by Gender Penn Medical School Faculty, 12/31/03

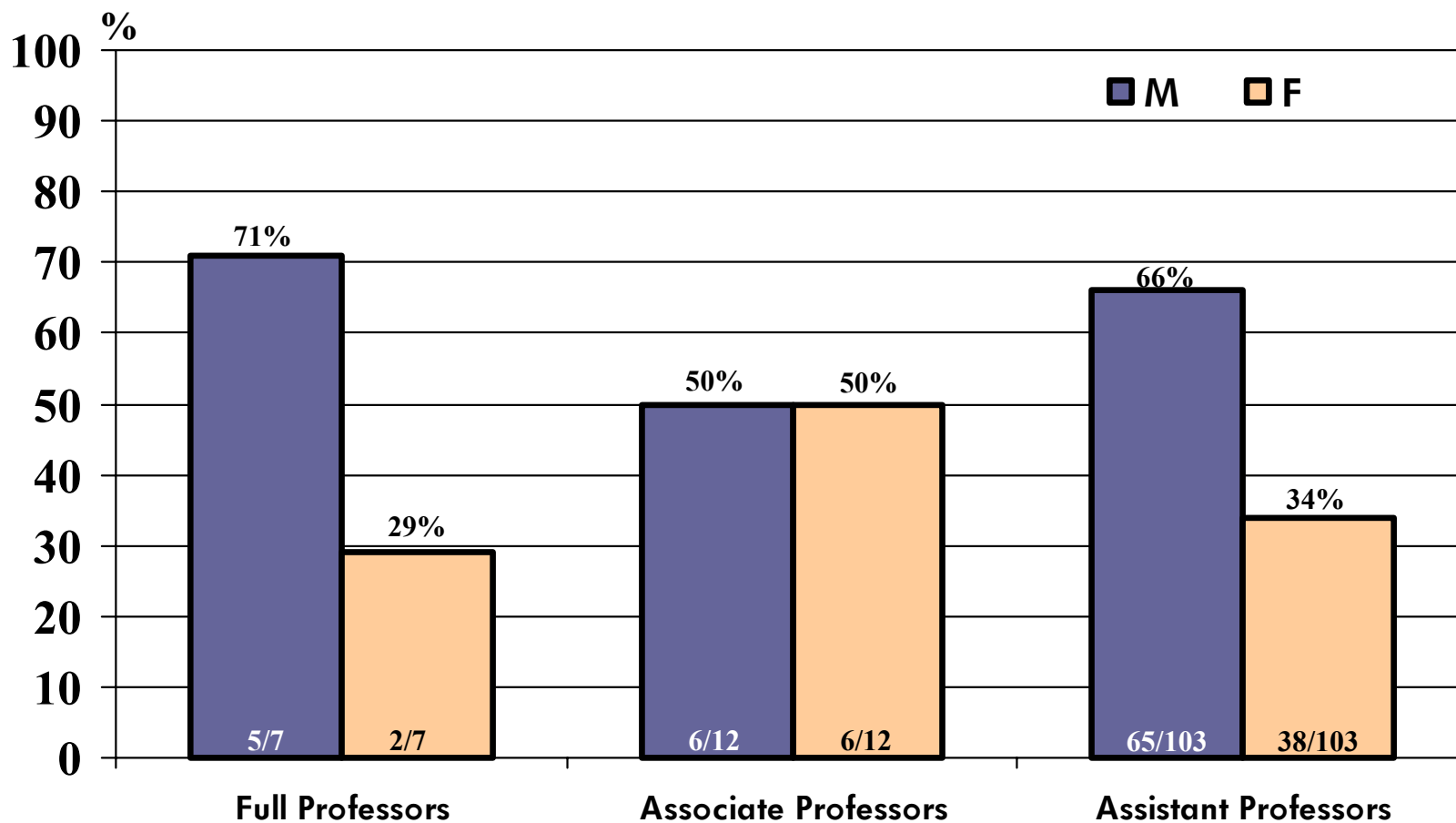

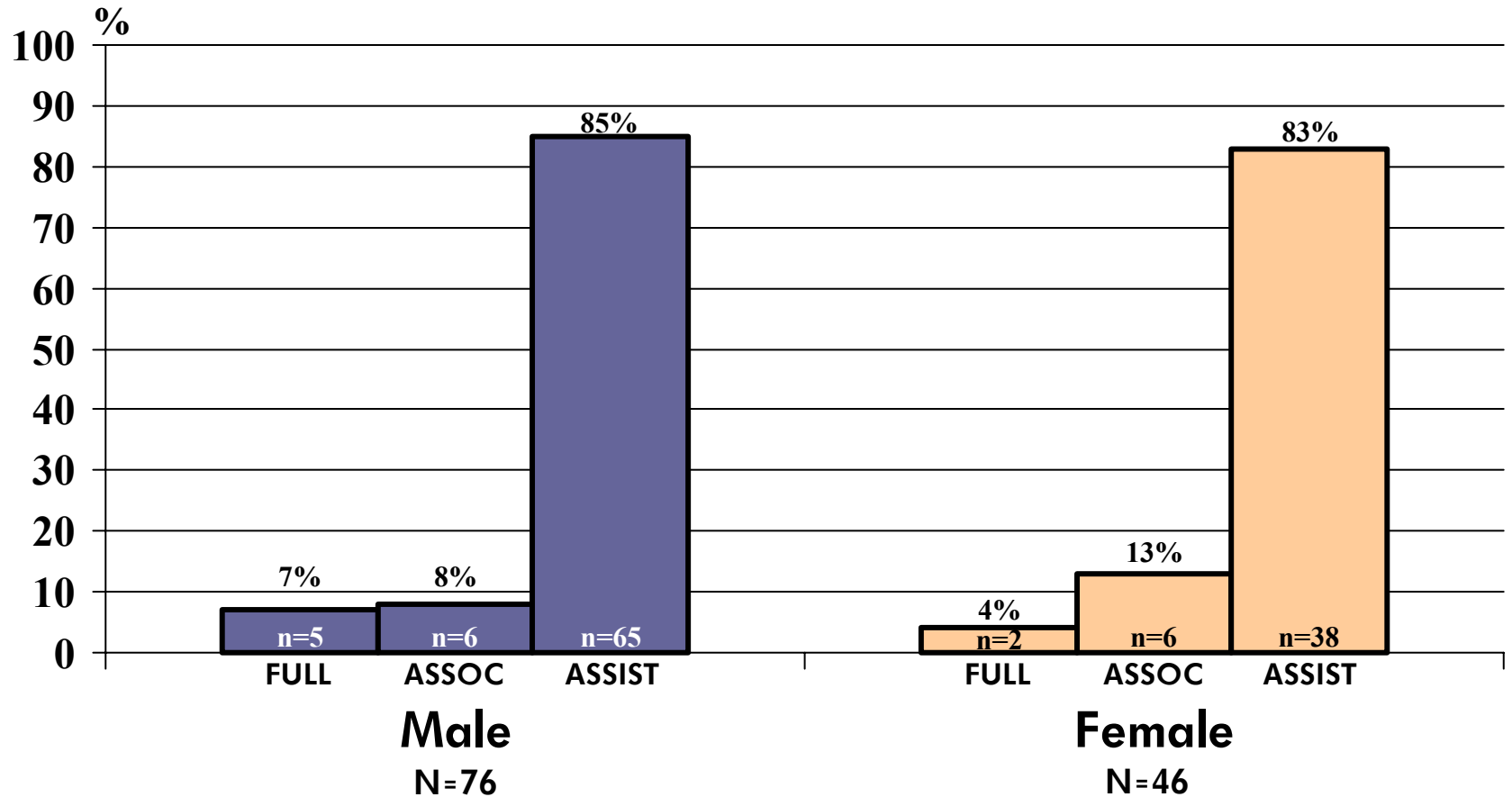

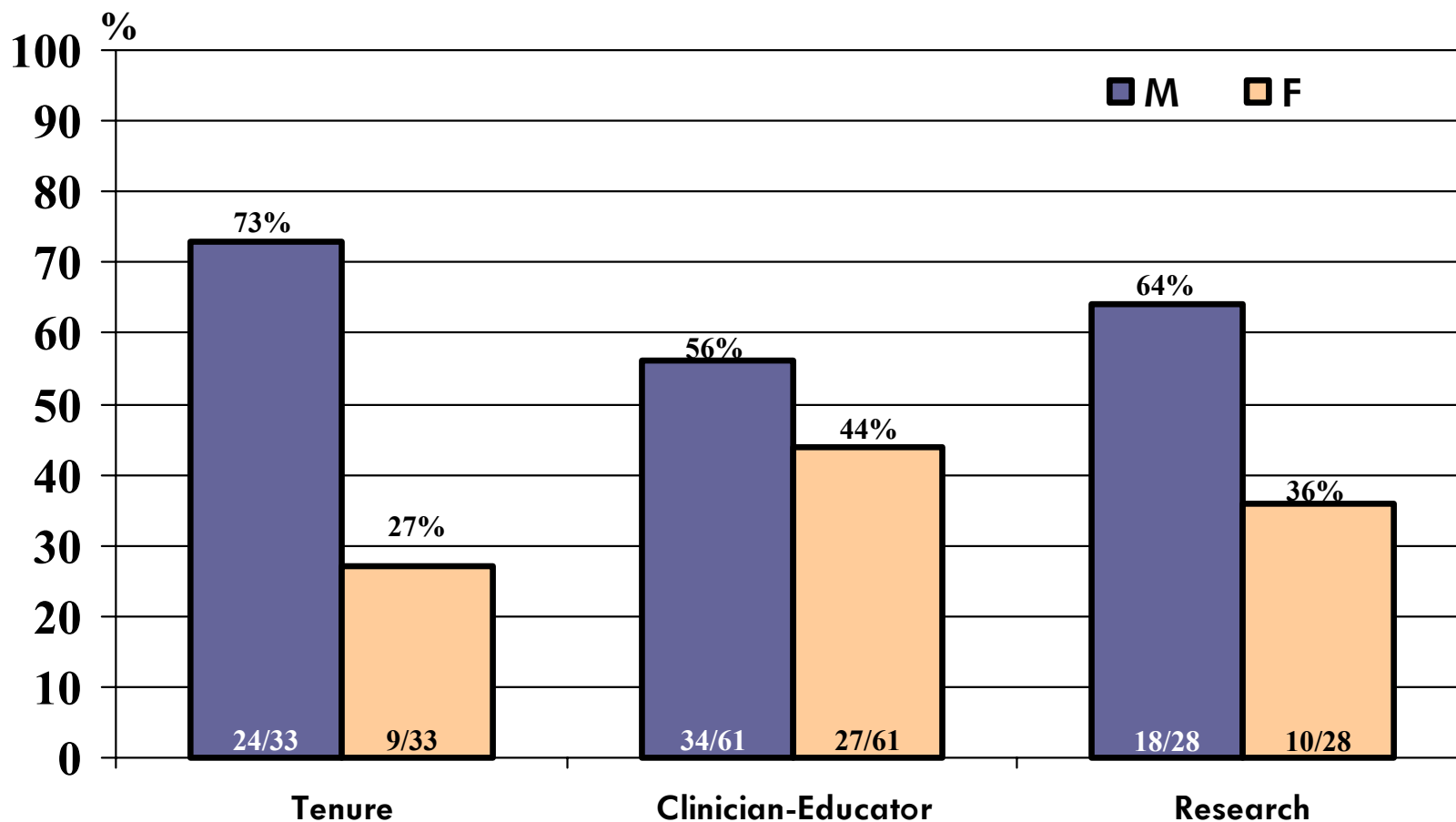

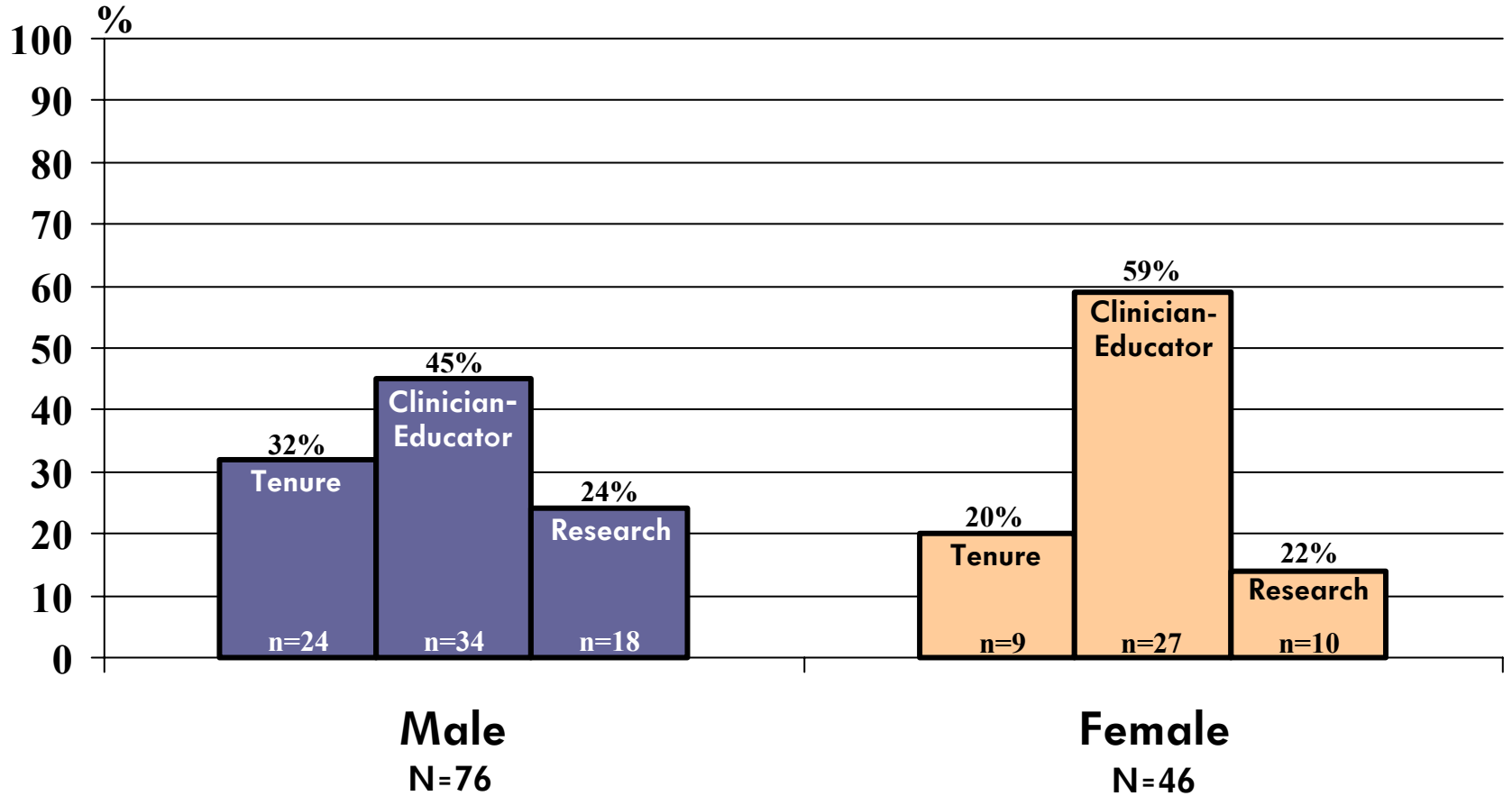

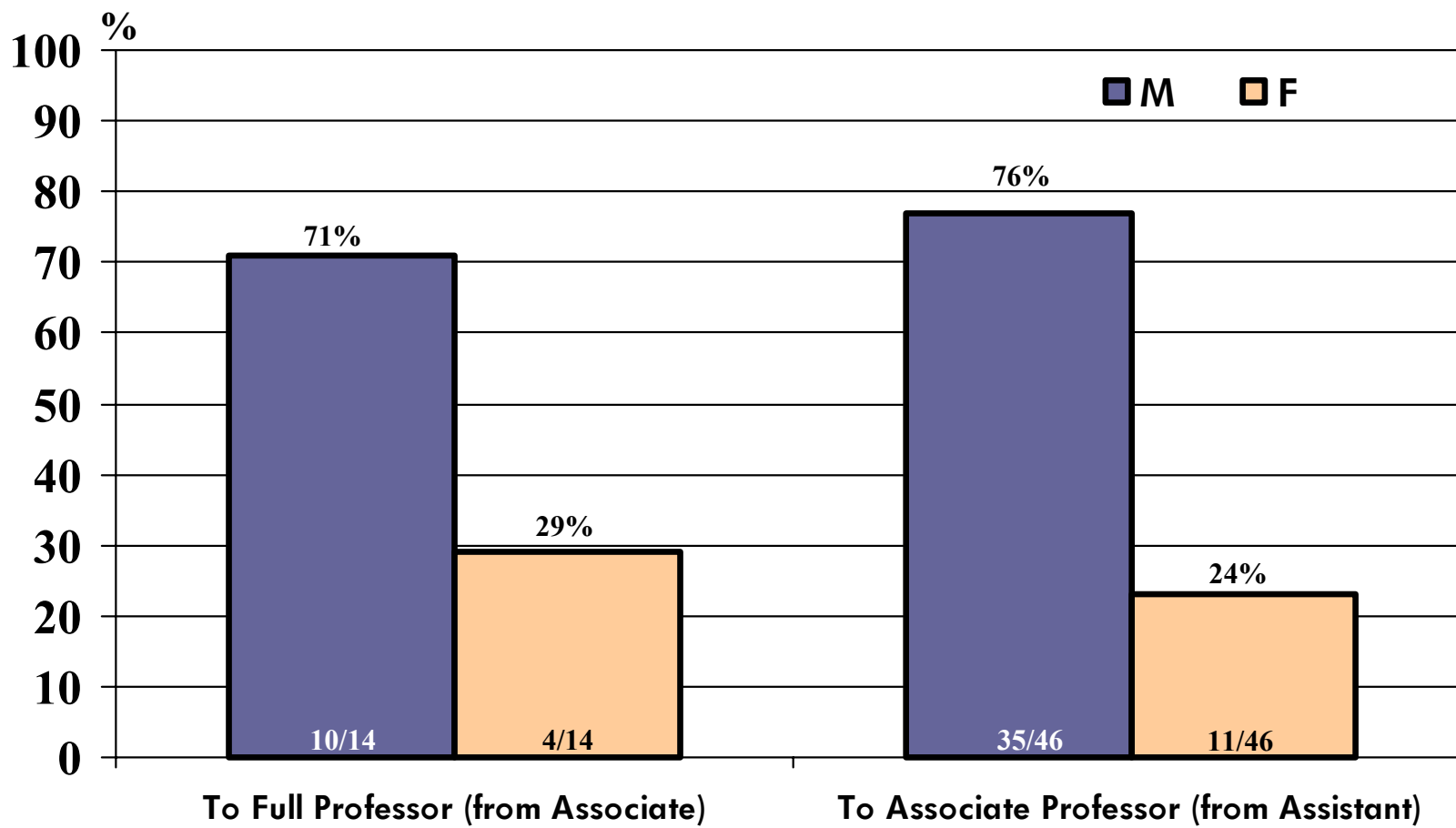

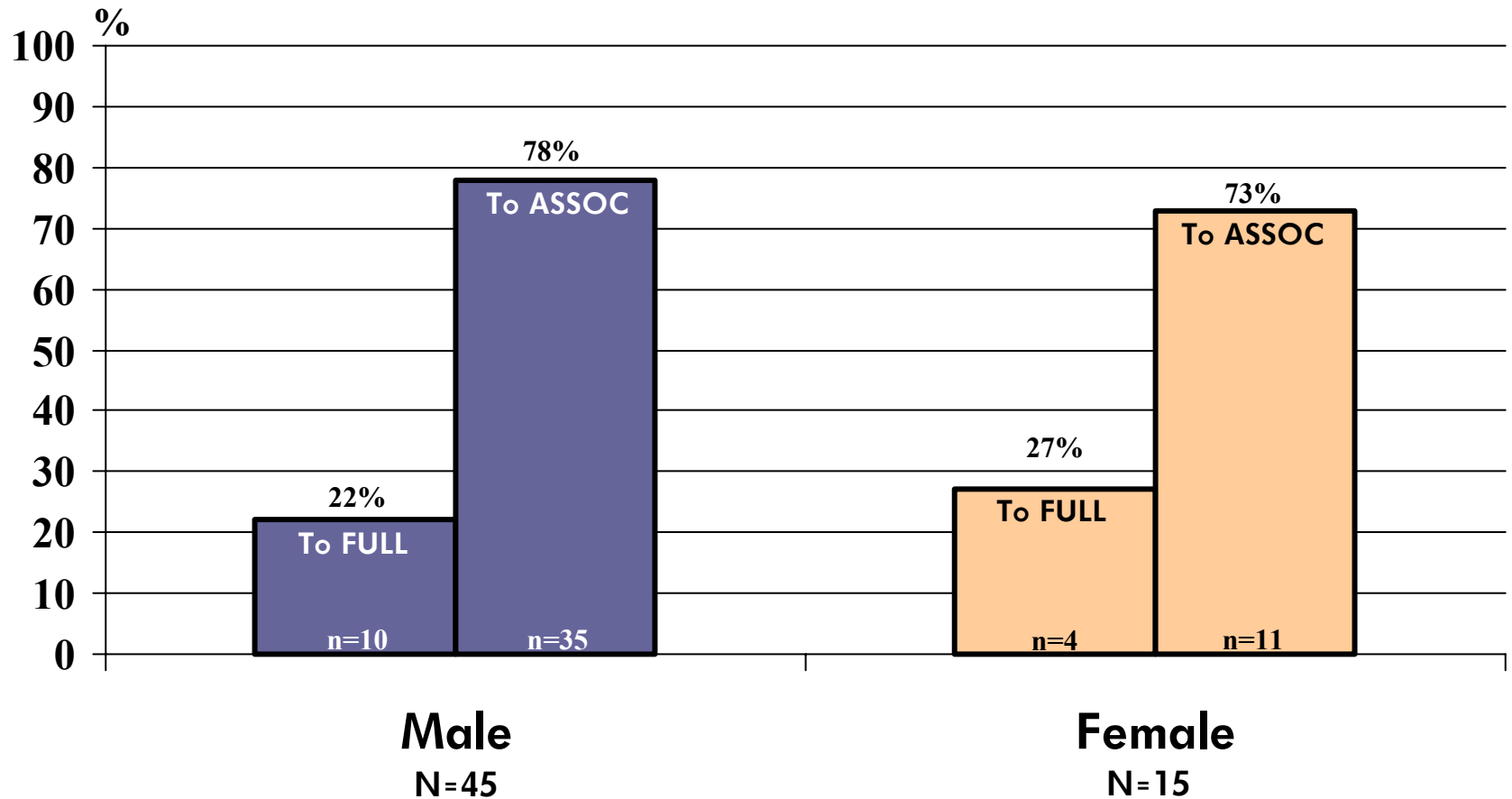

Faculty Promotions by Rank & Gender

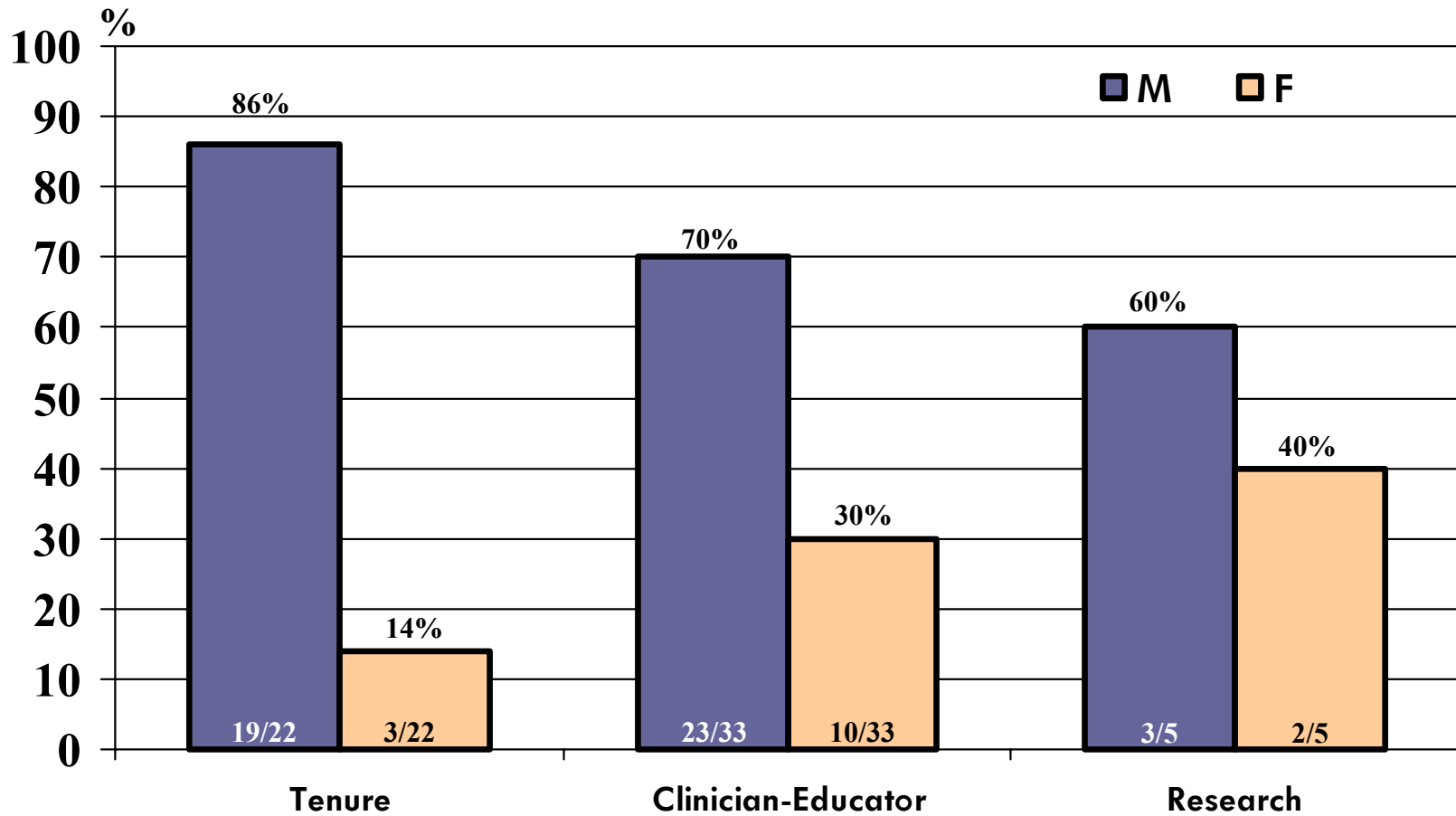

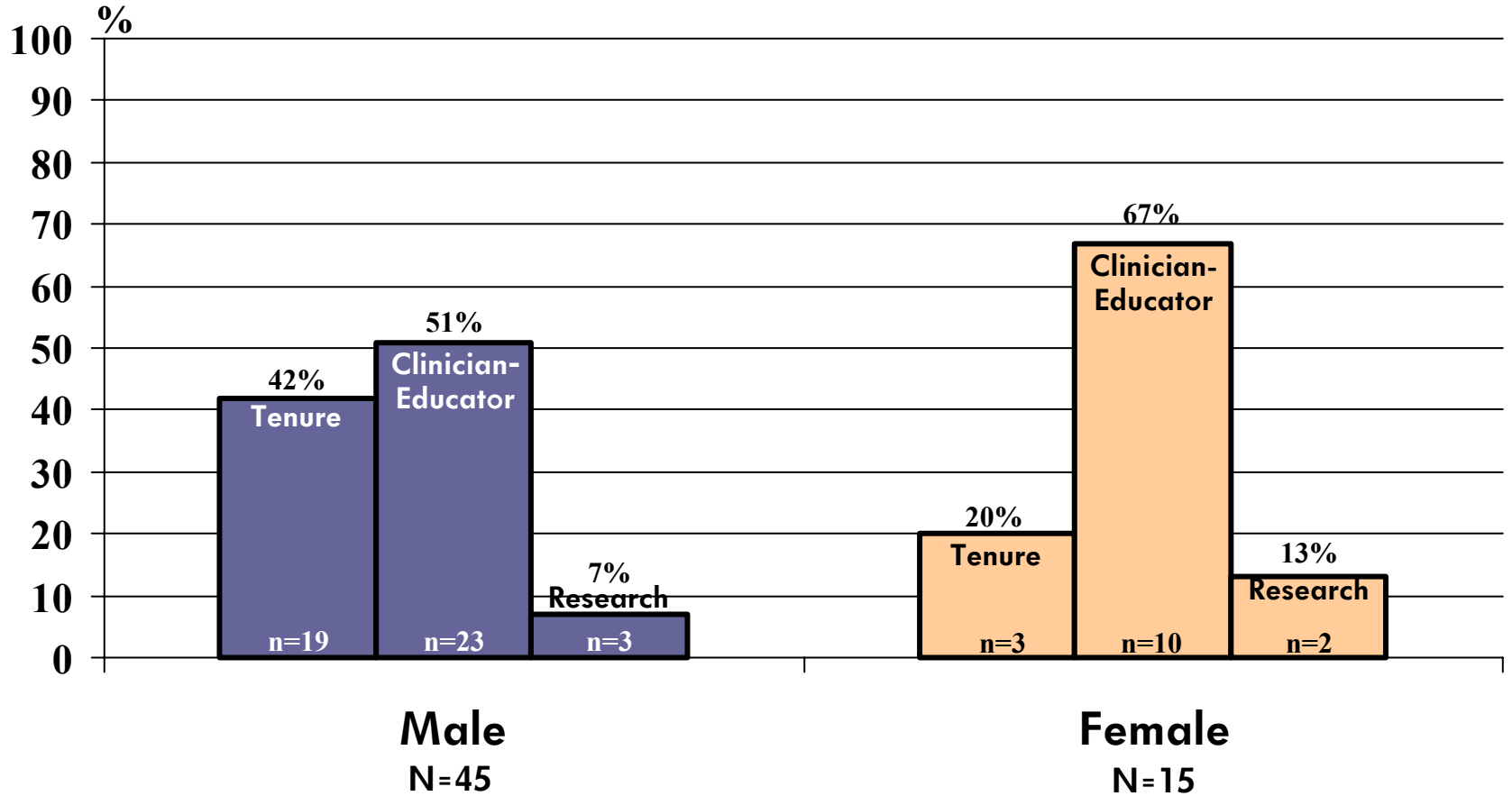


Faculty Promotions within Tracks

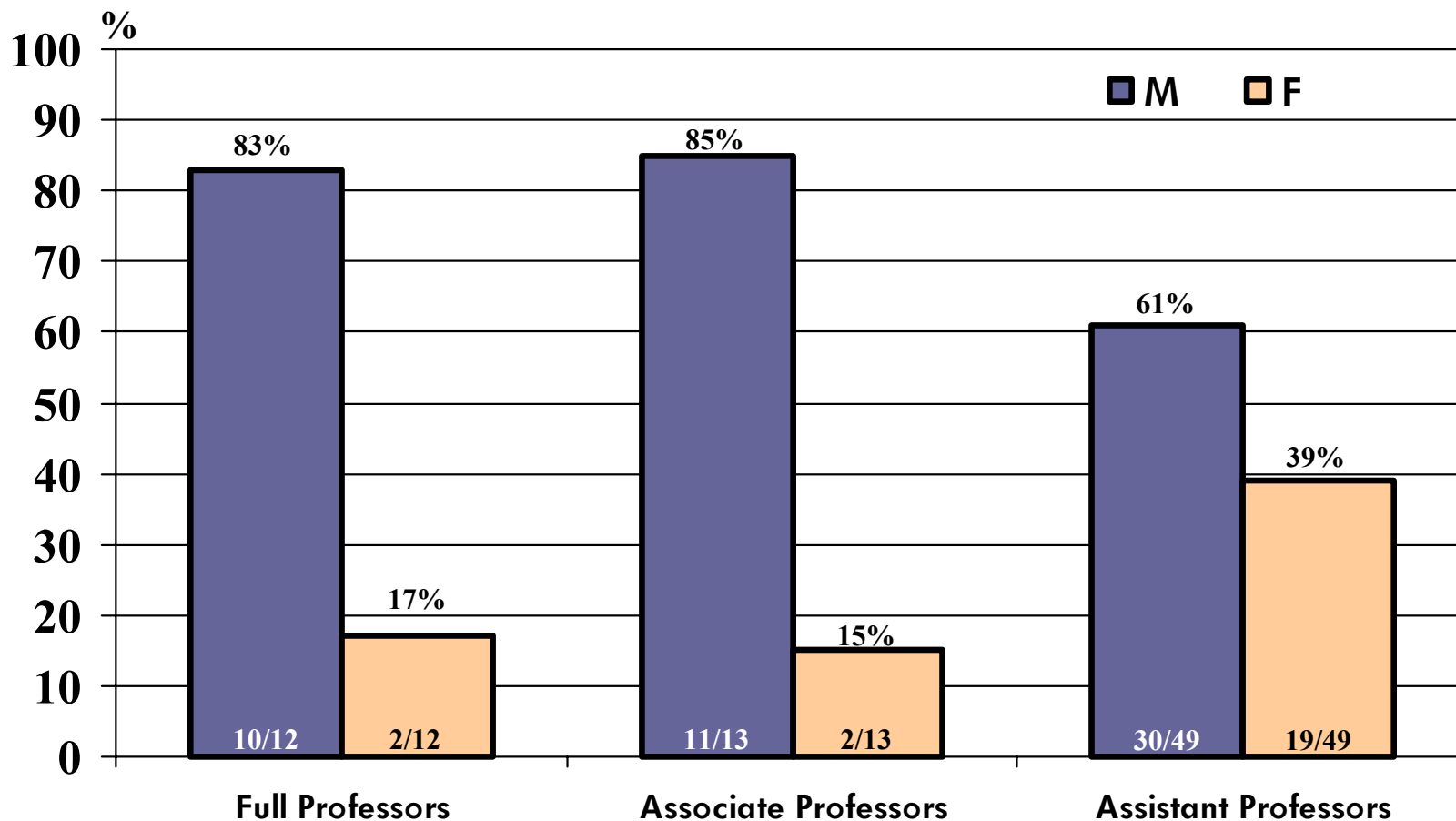

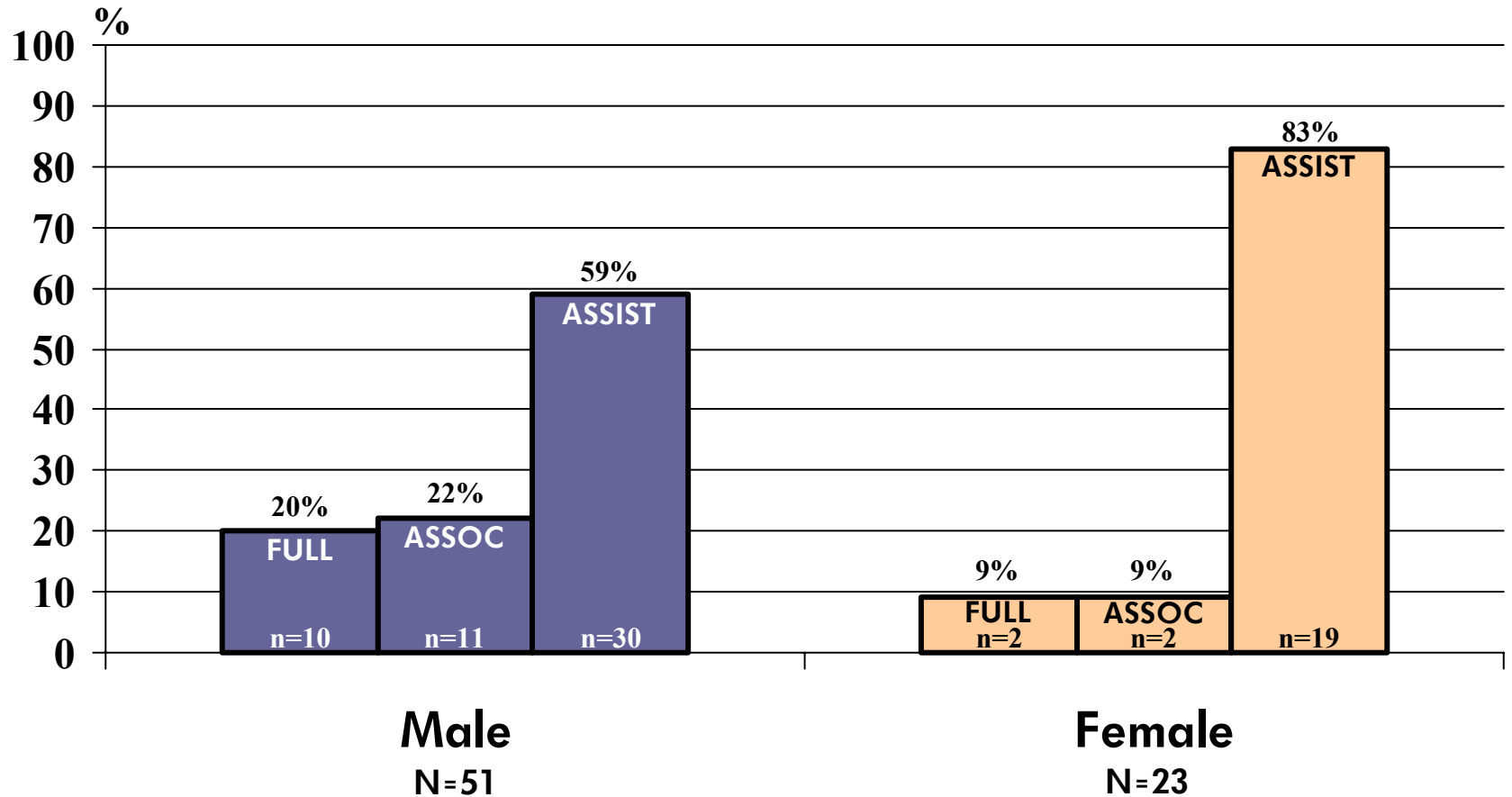

Faculty Terminations by Rank & Gender

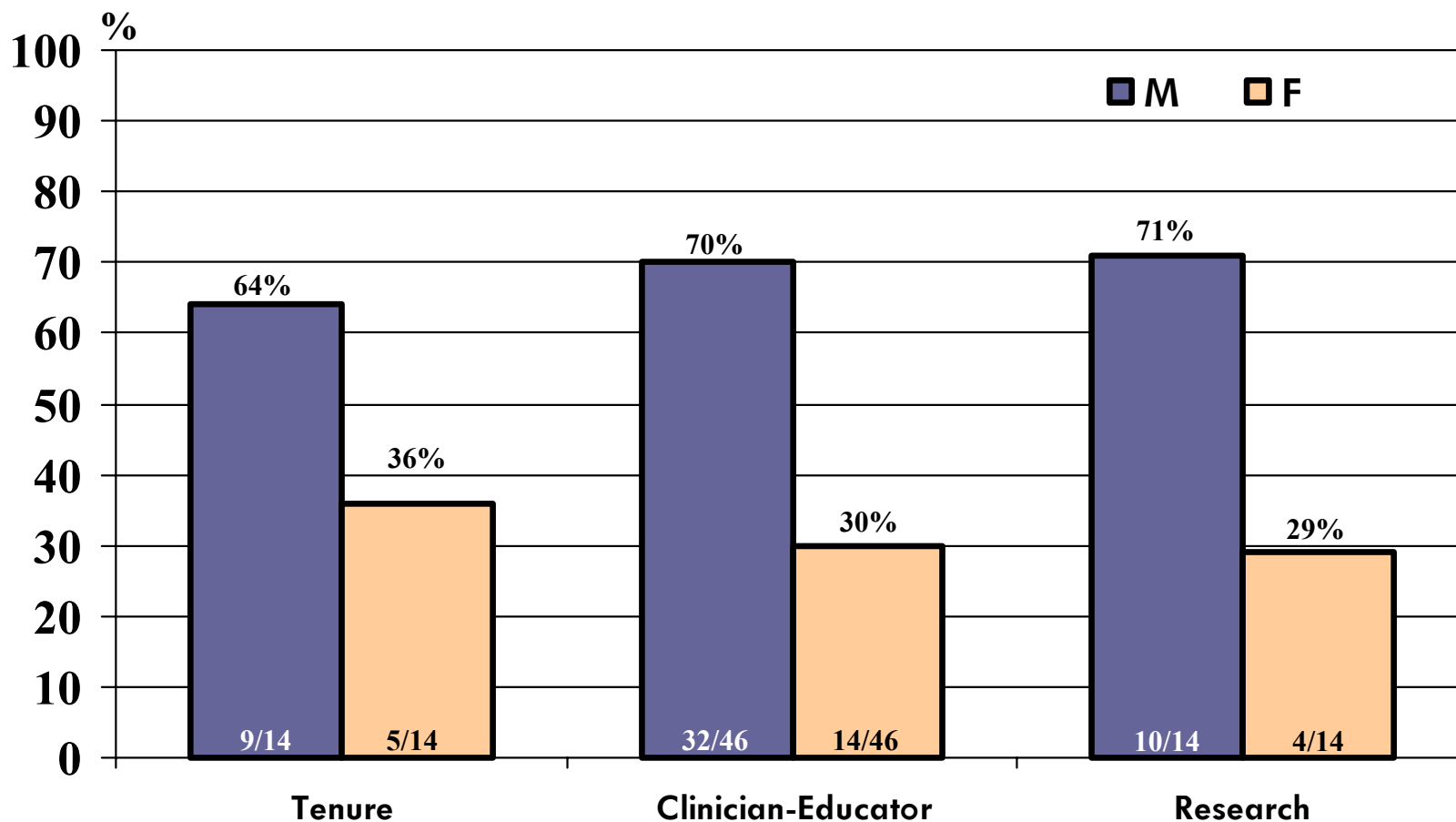

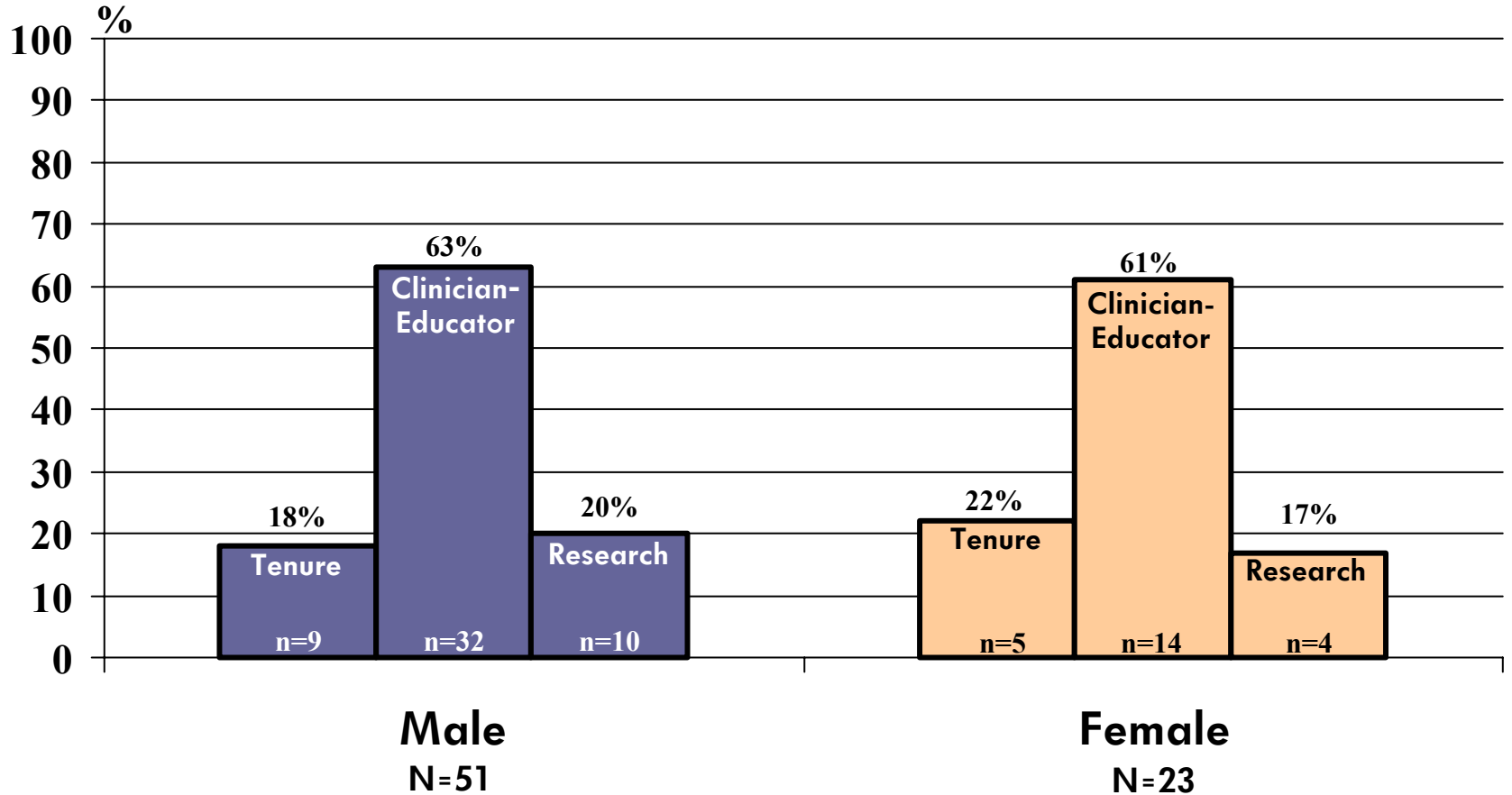


Faculty Terminations within Tracks

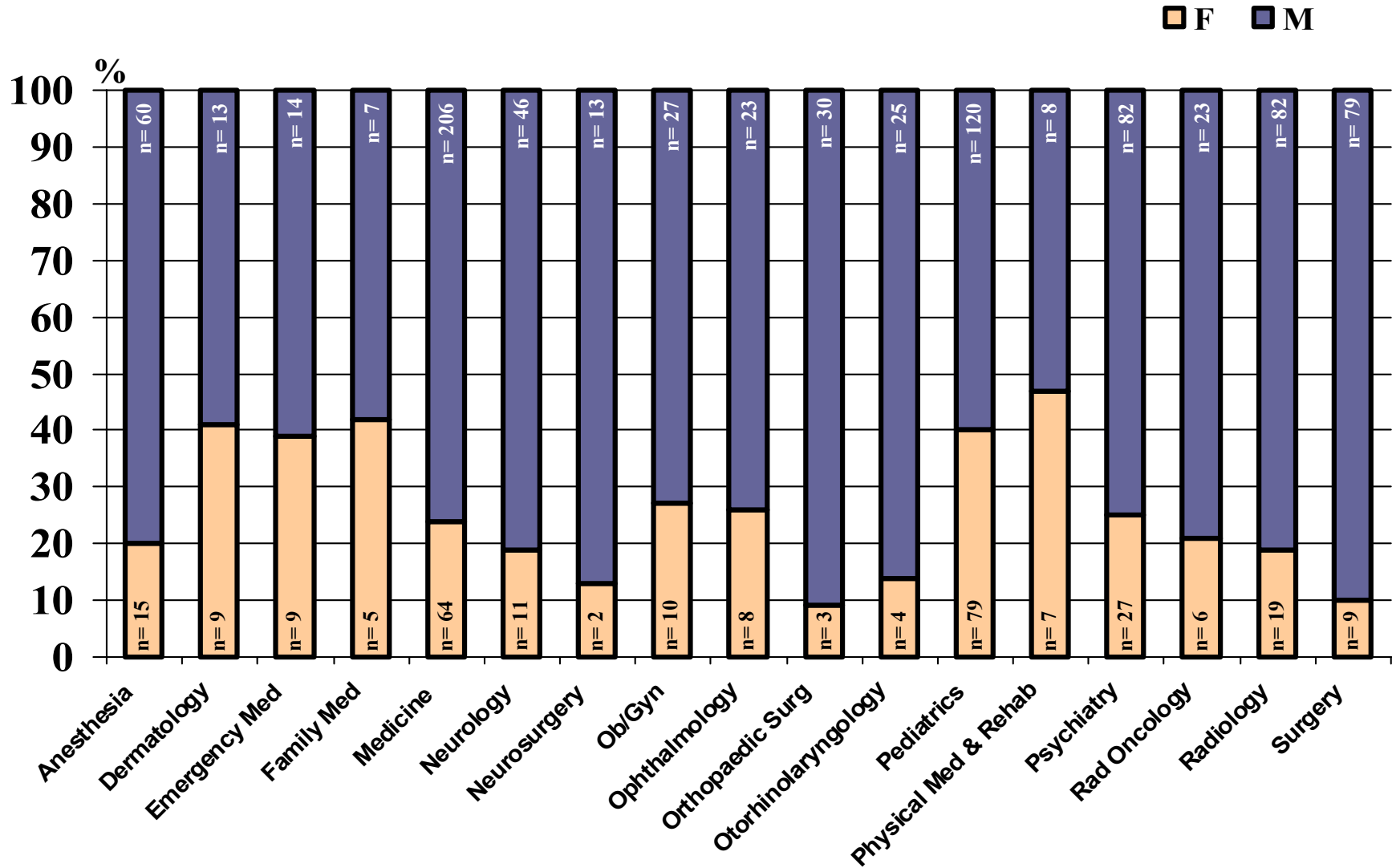

Gender Distribution by Clinical Department

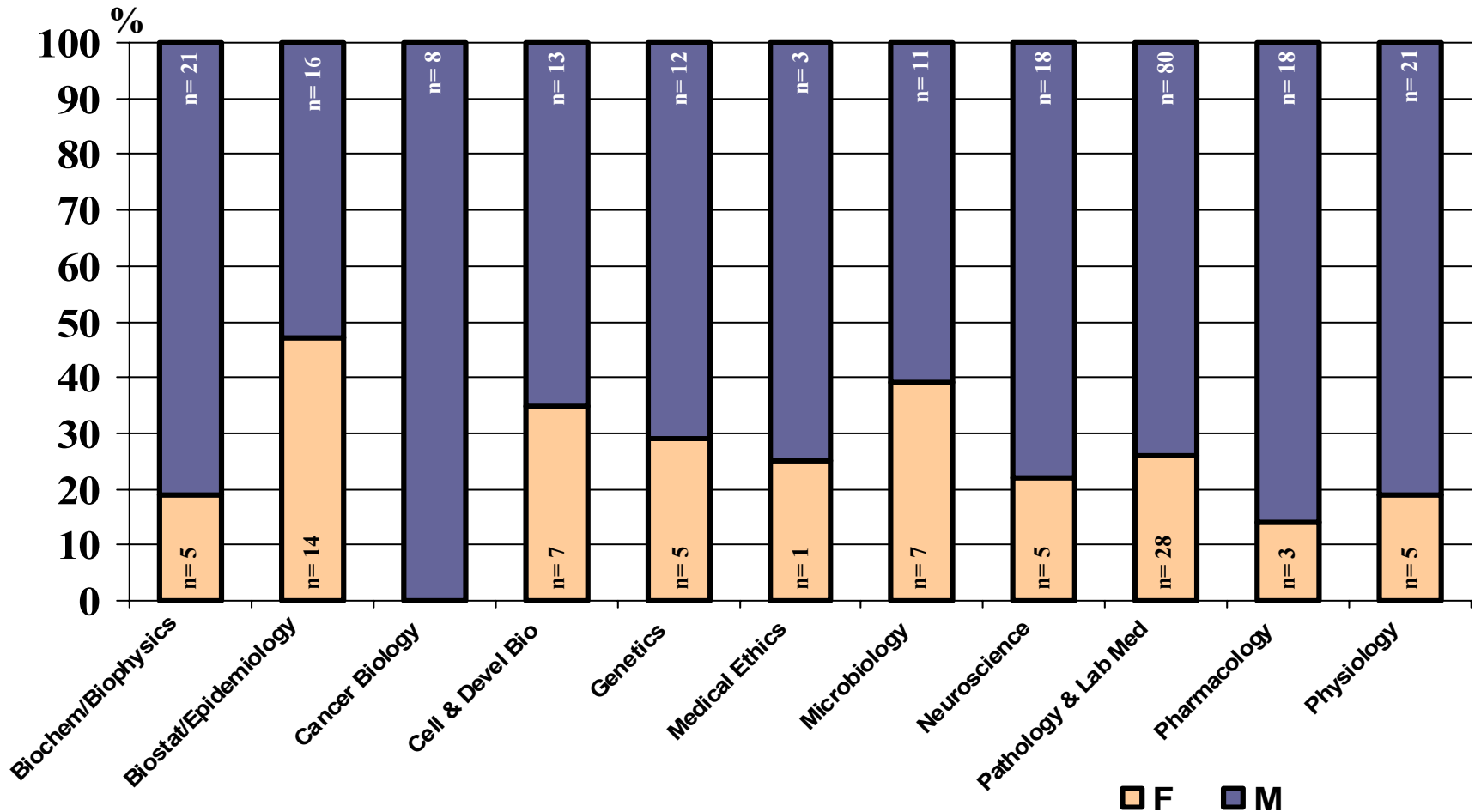

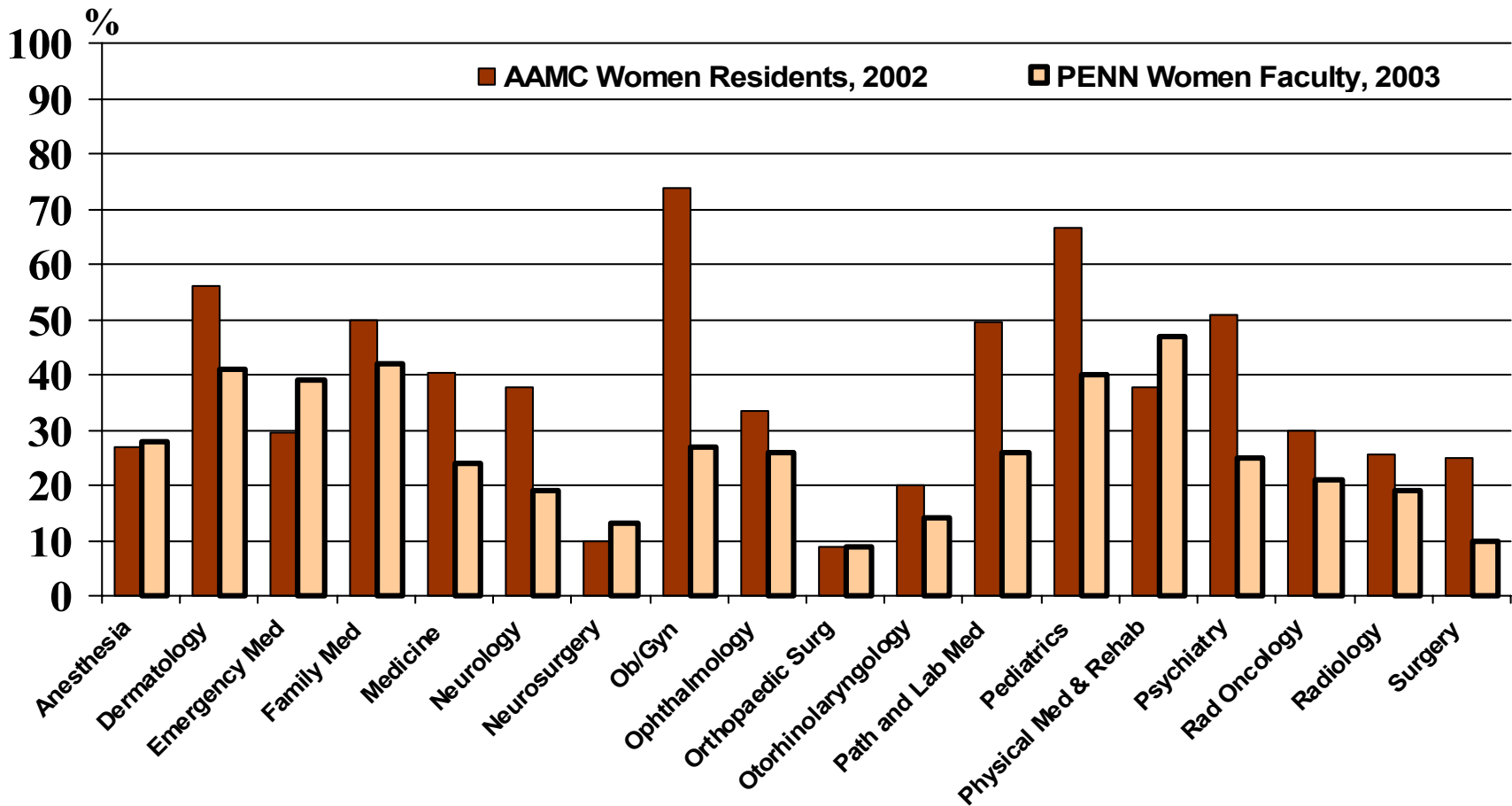

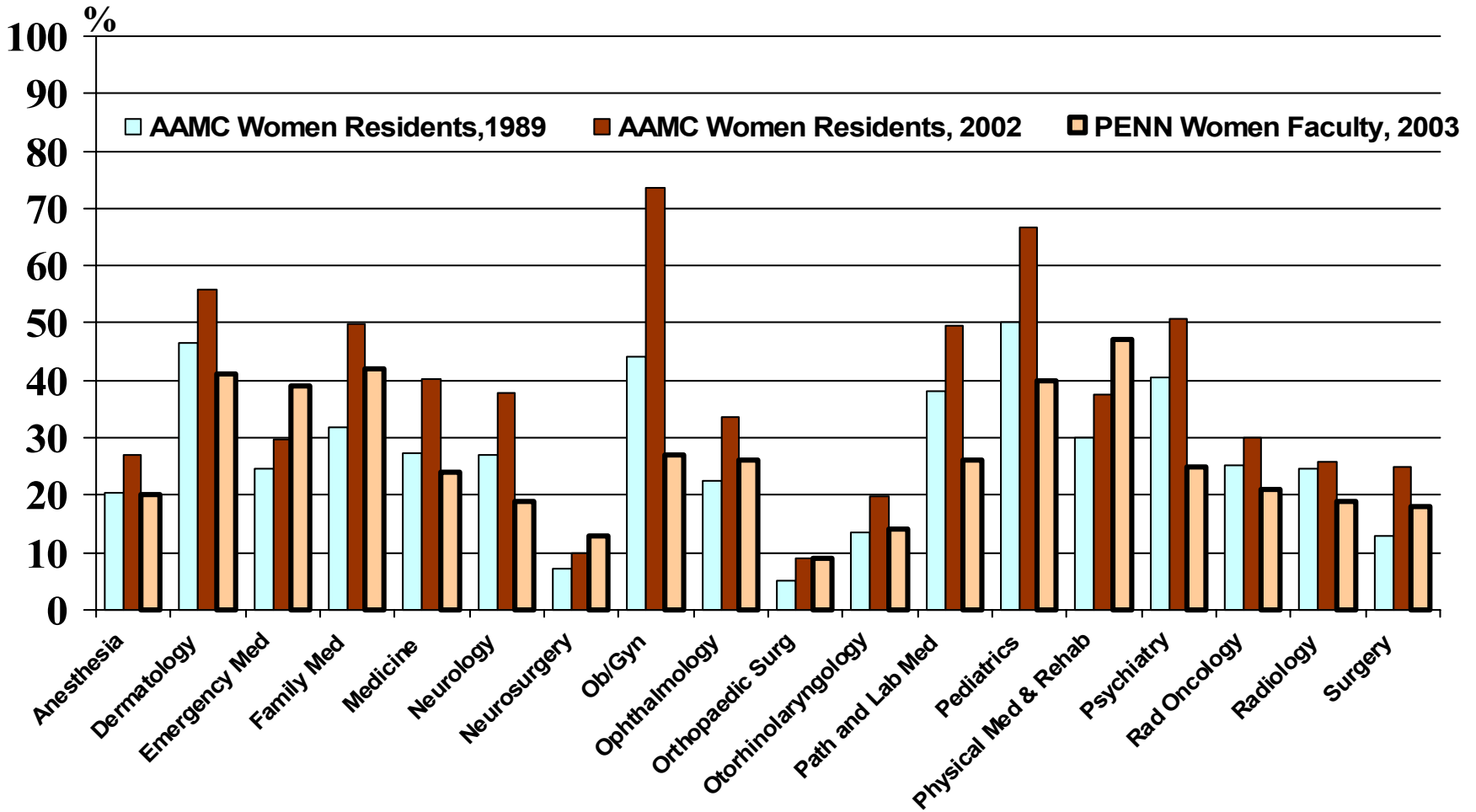

AAMC Percent Women Residents by Specialty, 1989 and 2002

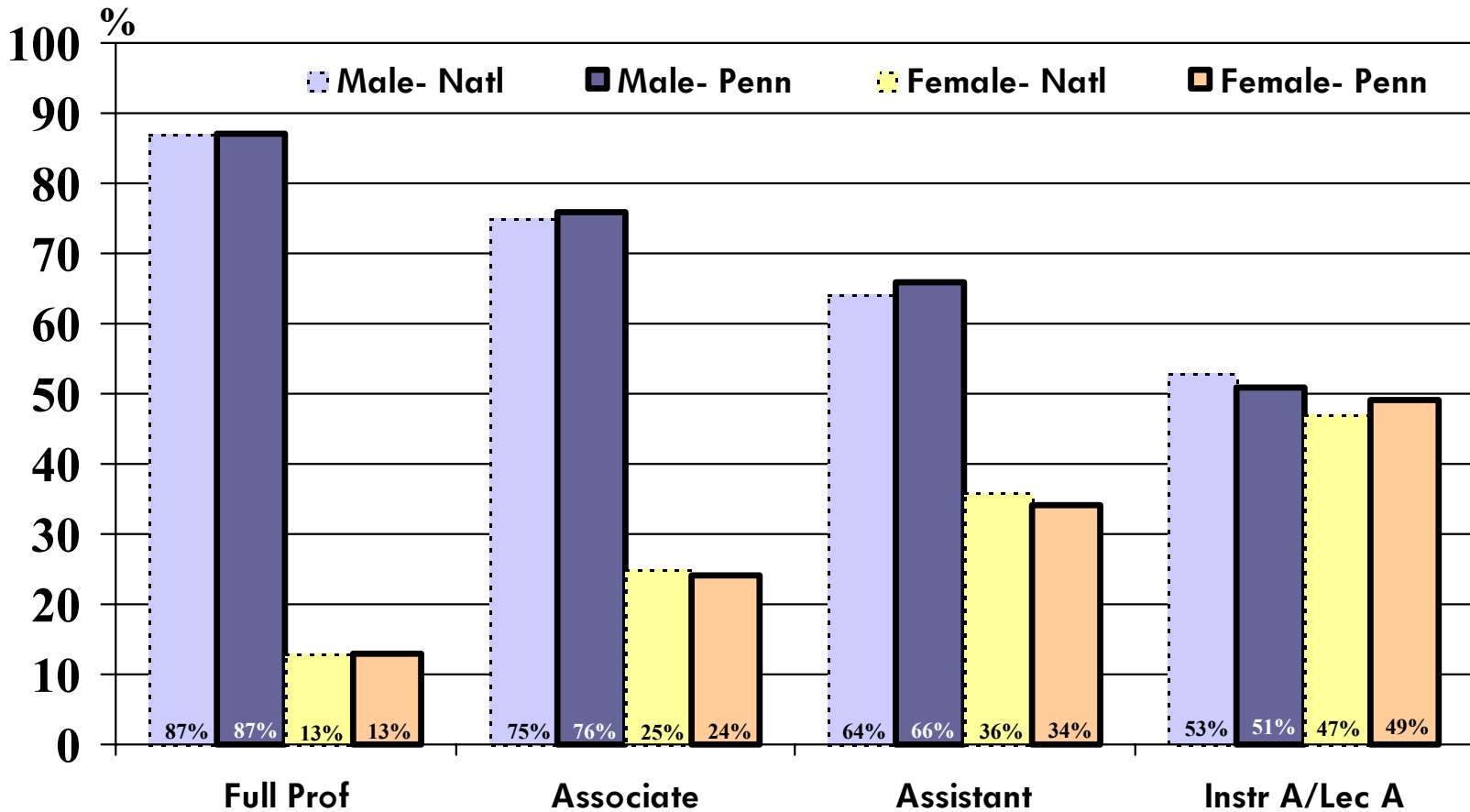
Penn Percent Women Medical Faculty by Specialty, 2003

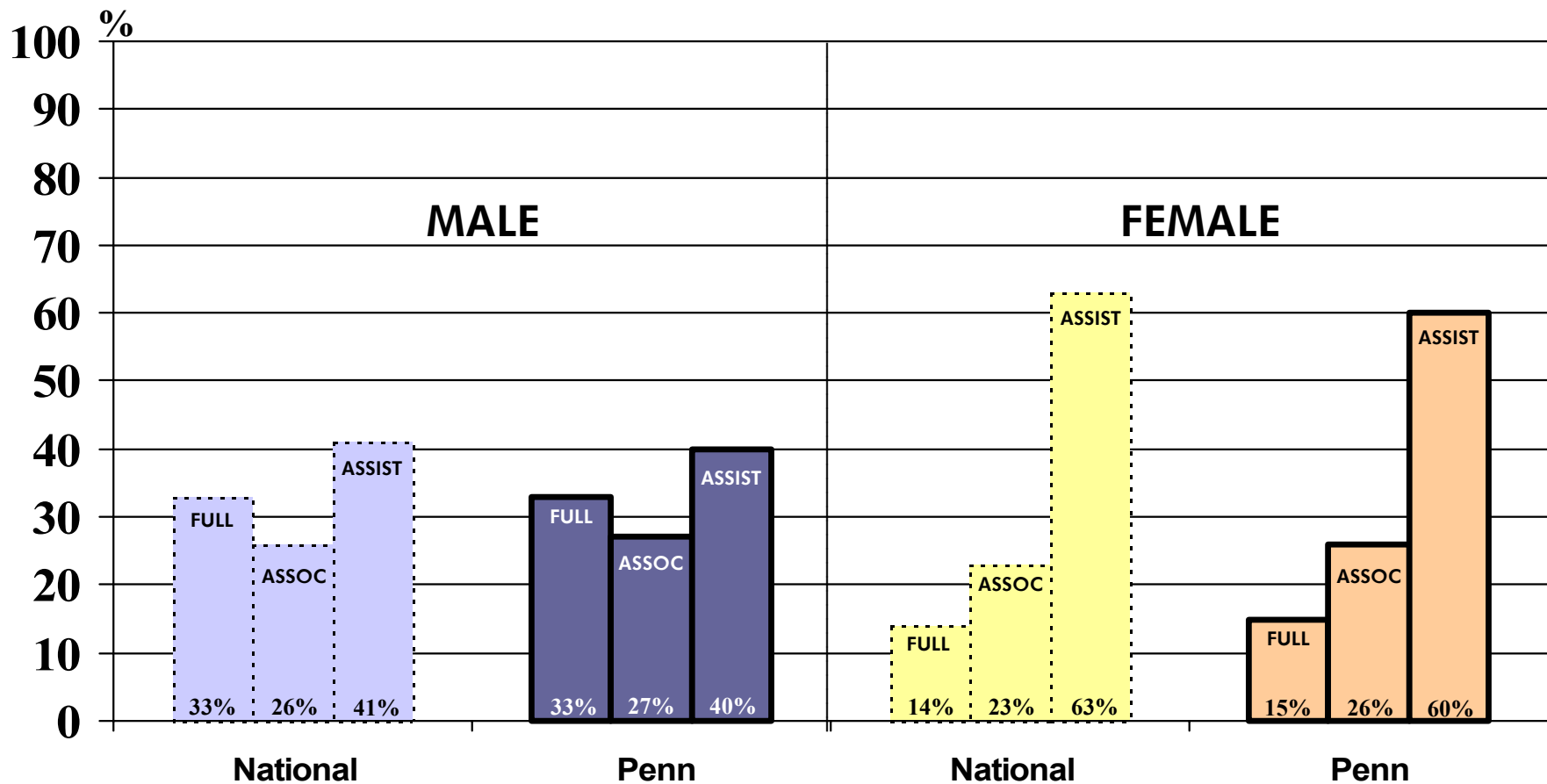

Distribution of Medical School Faculty by Rank and Gender

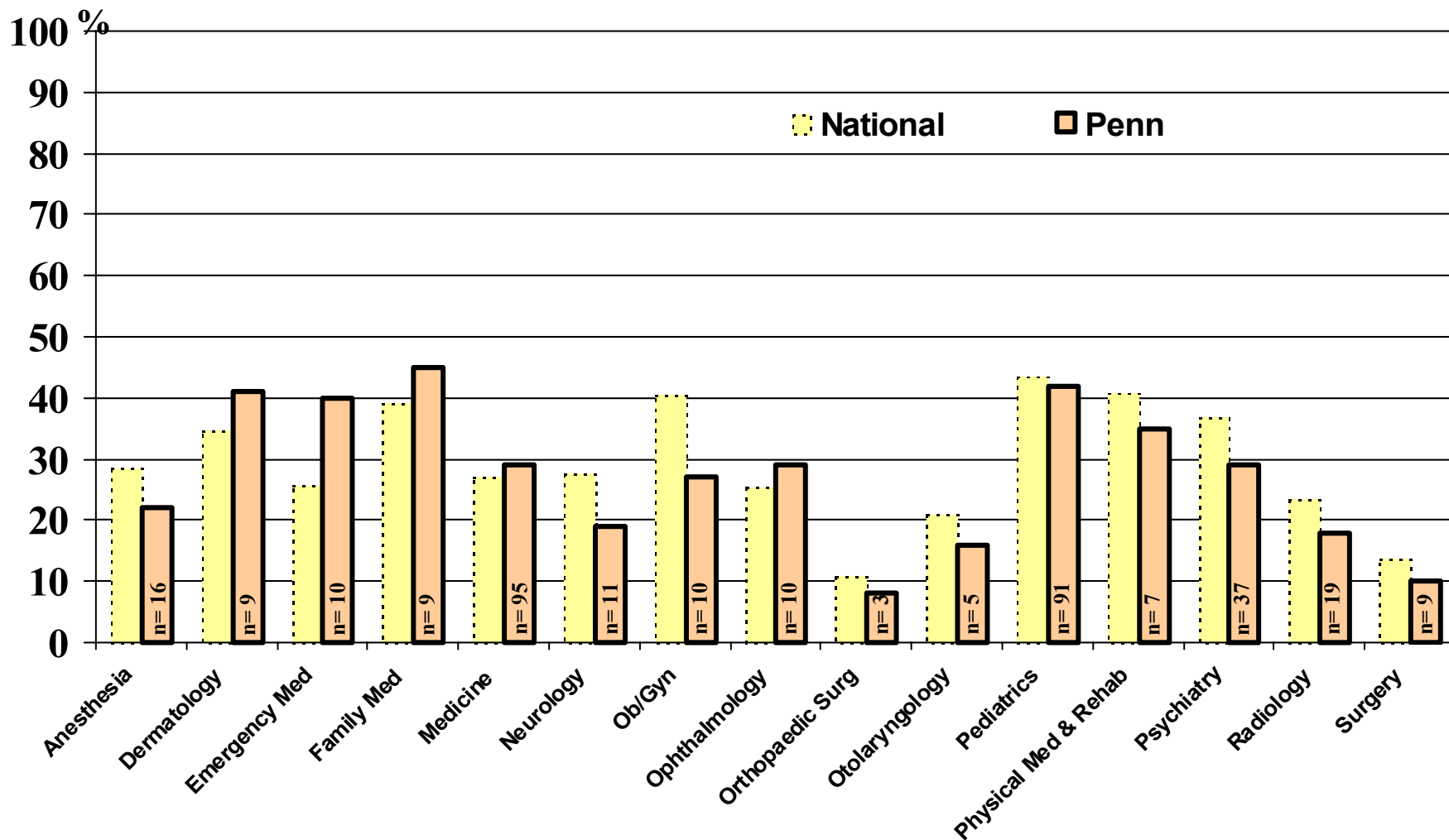

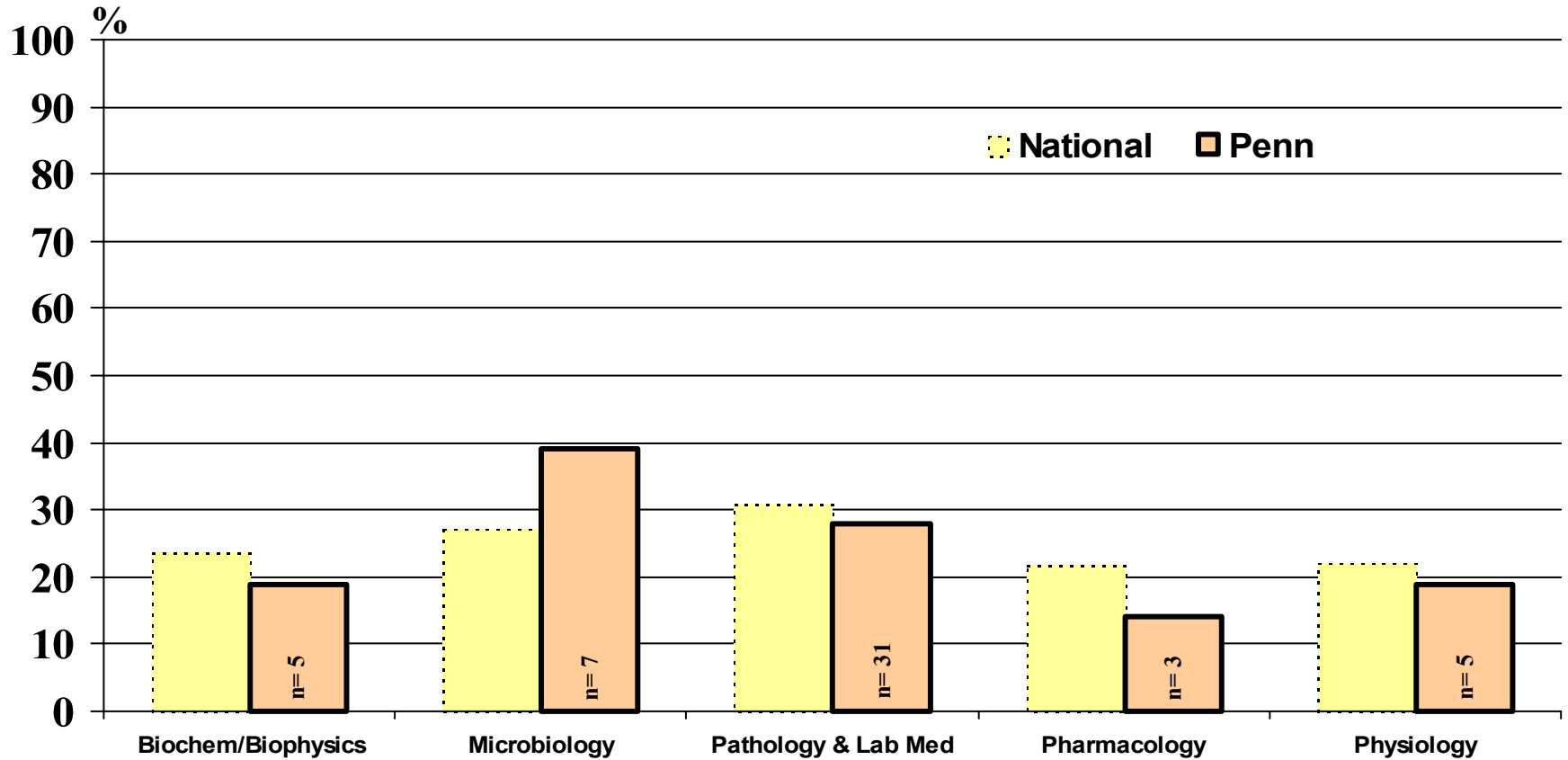
Percent Women Medical Faculty by Clinical Department Penn versus AAMC National Data, 12/31/03

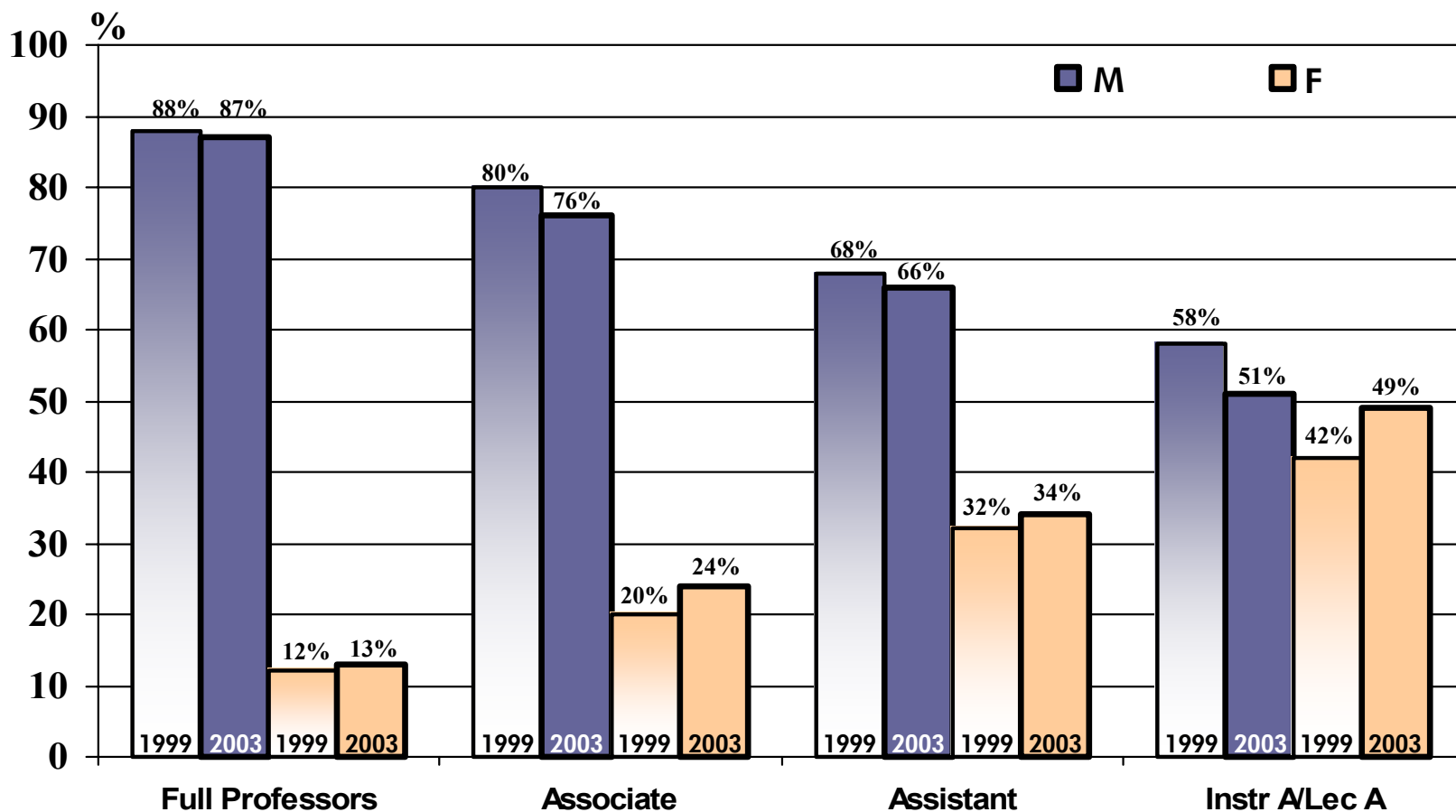

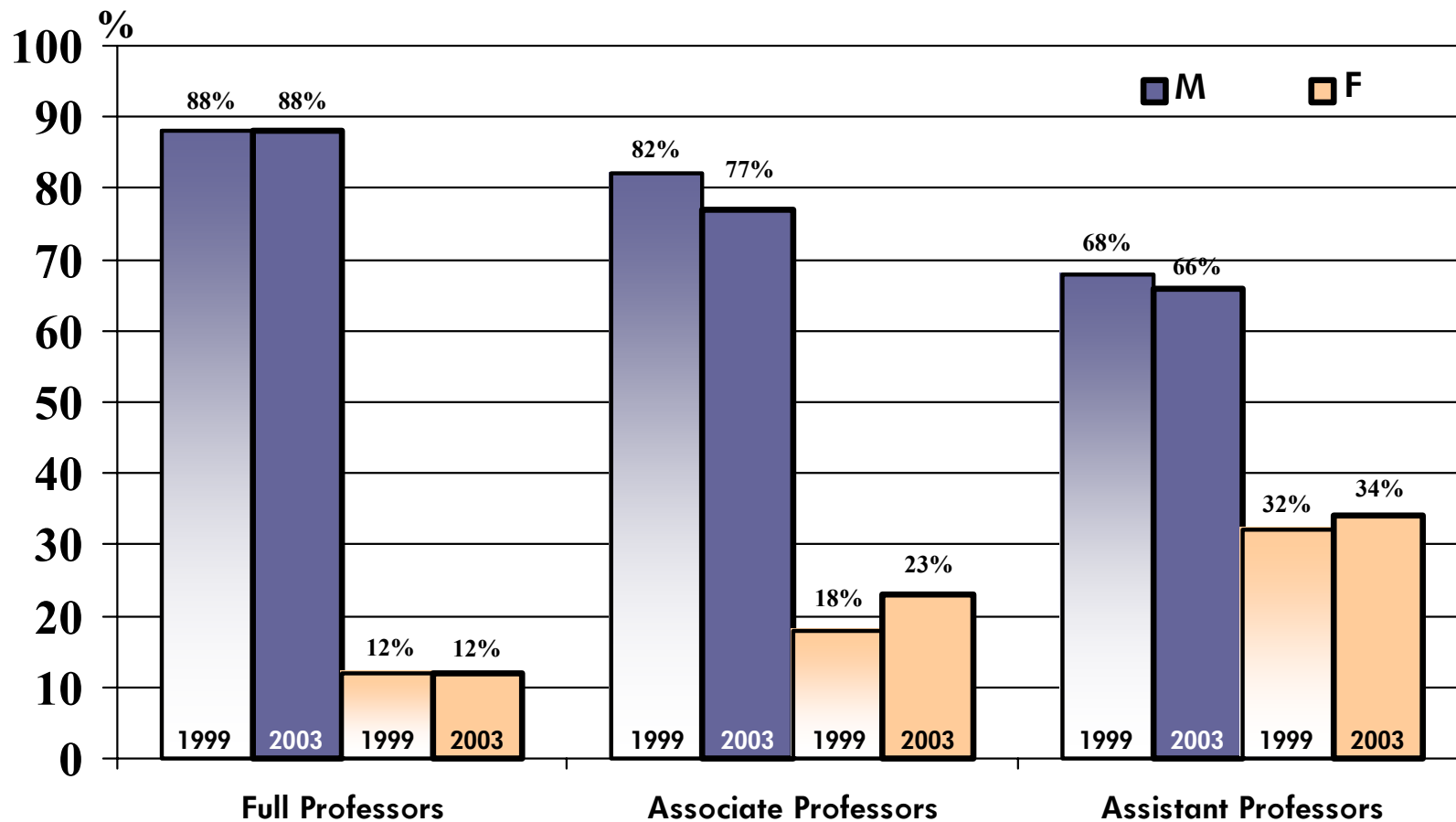

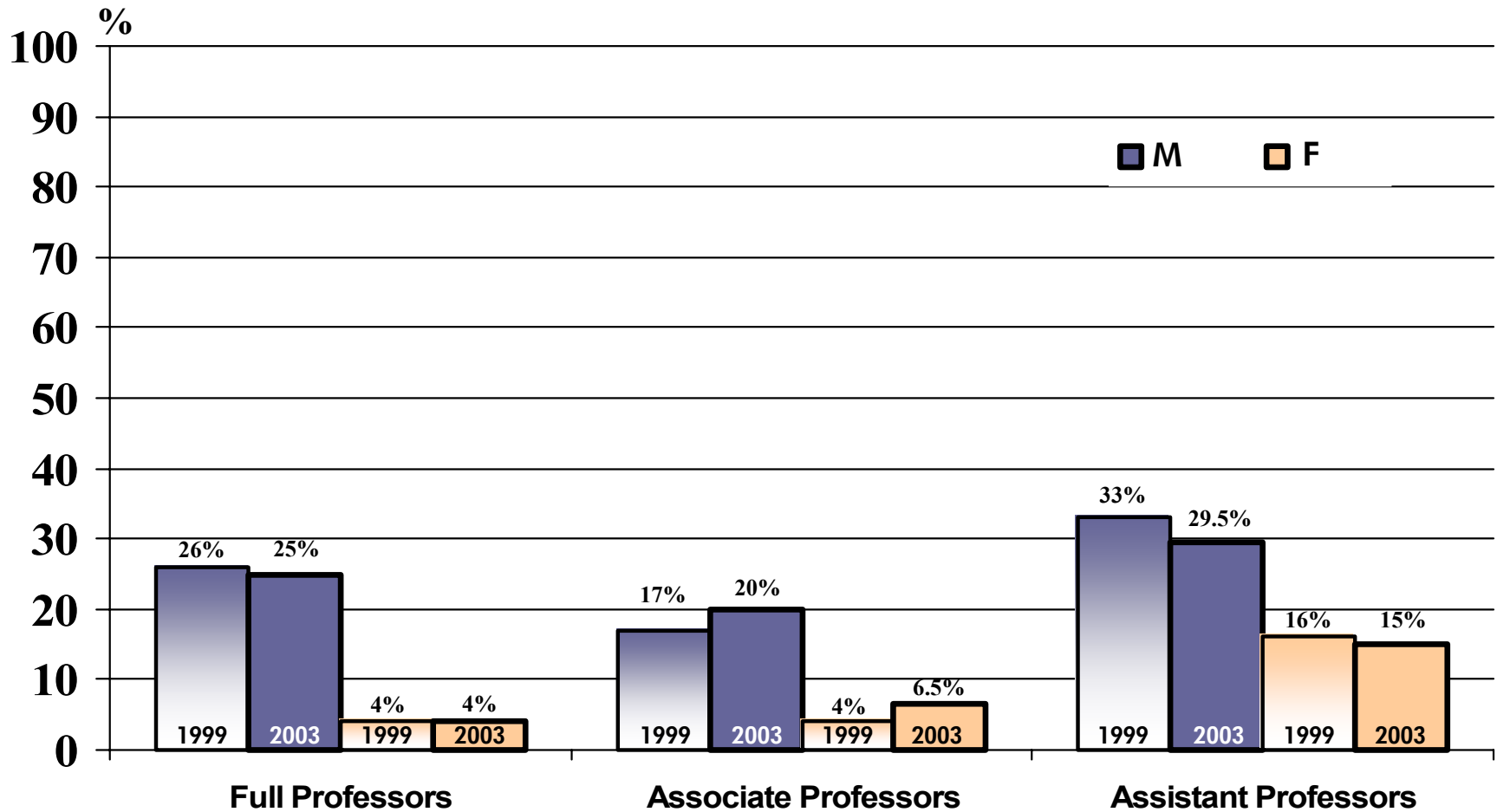

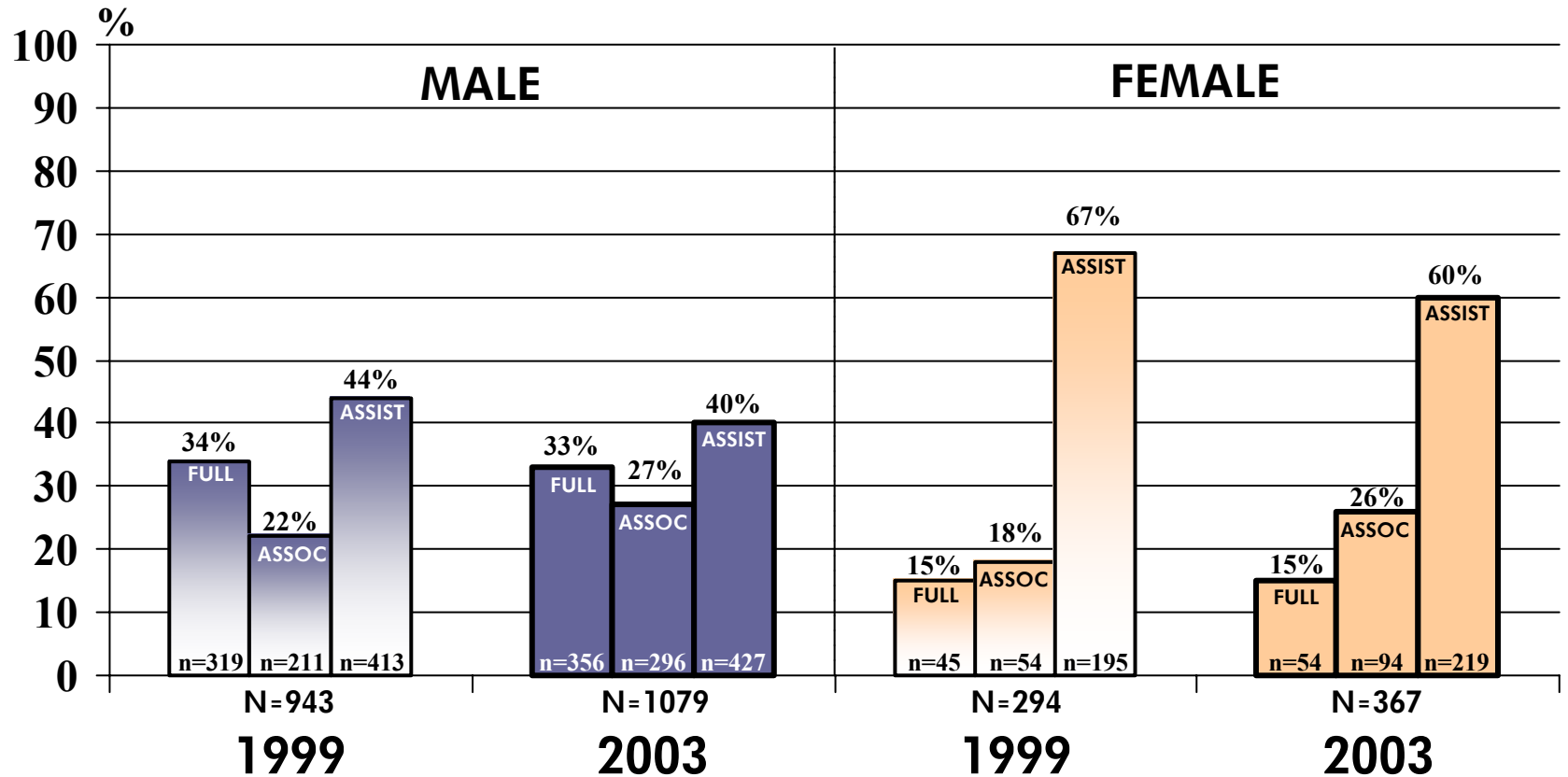

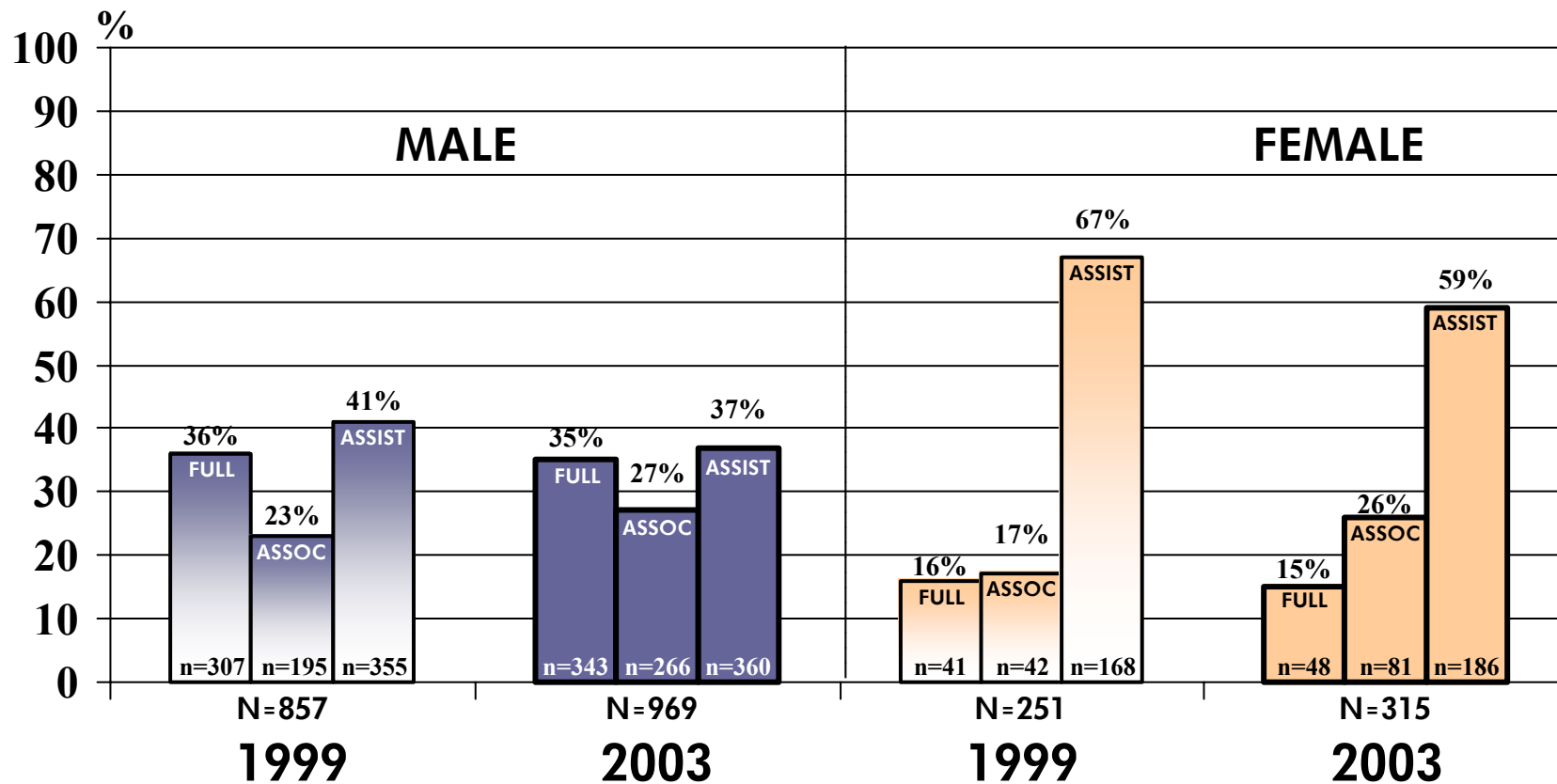

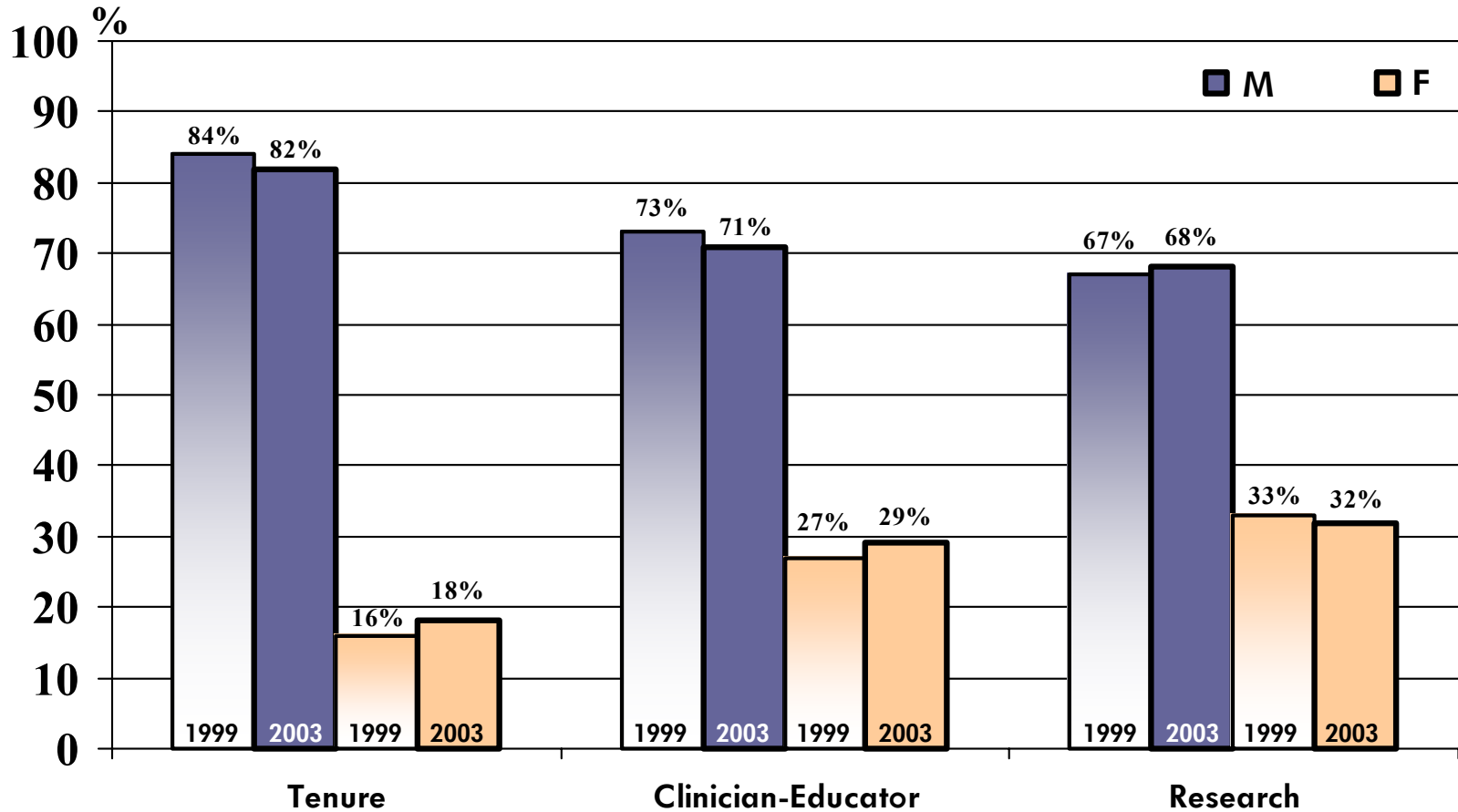

Gender Distribution within Tracks

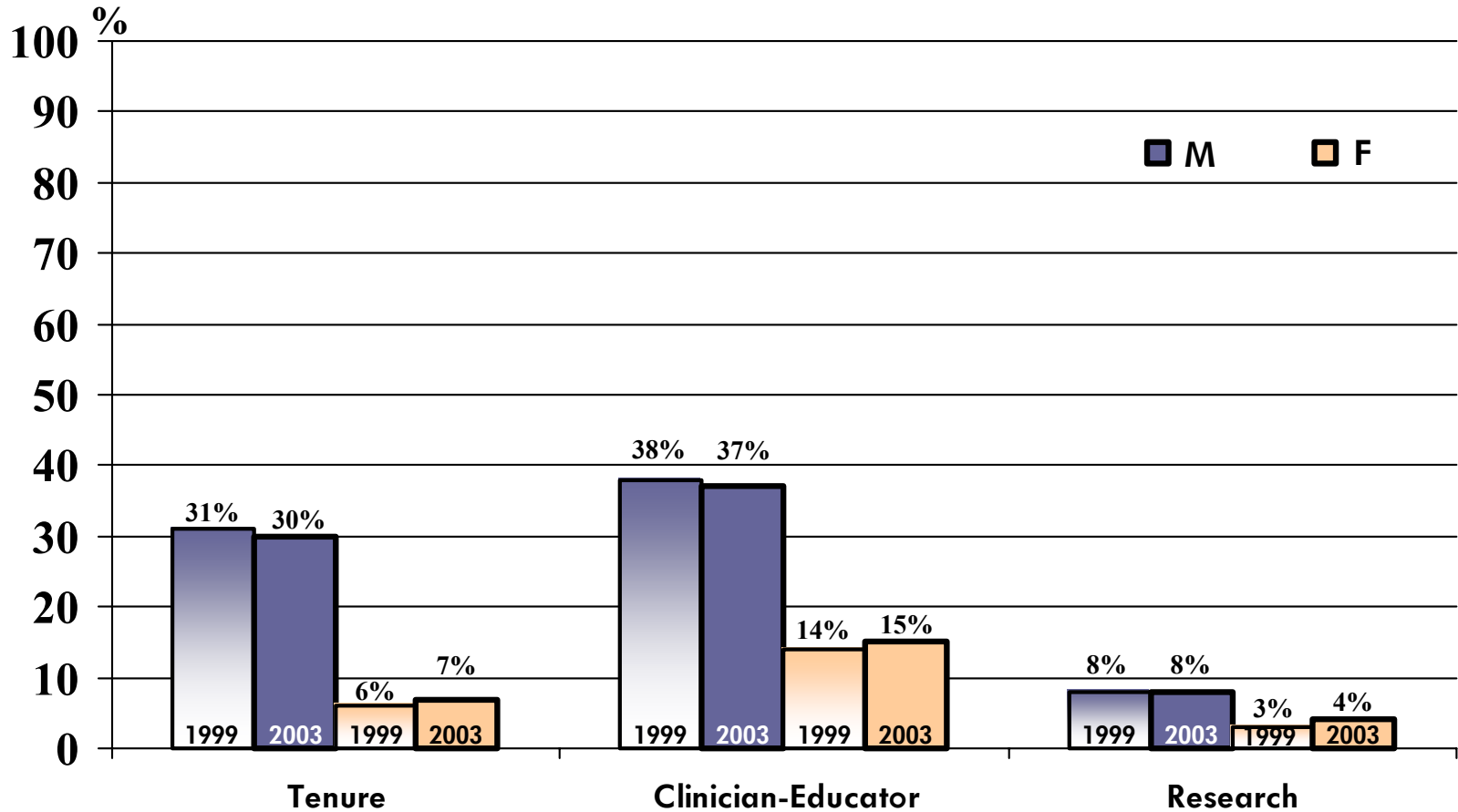

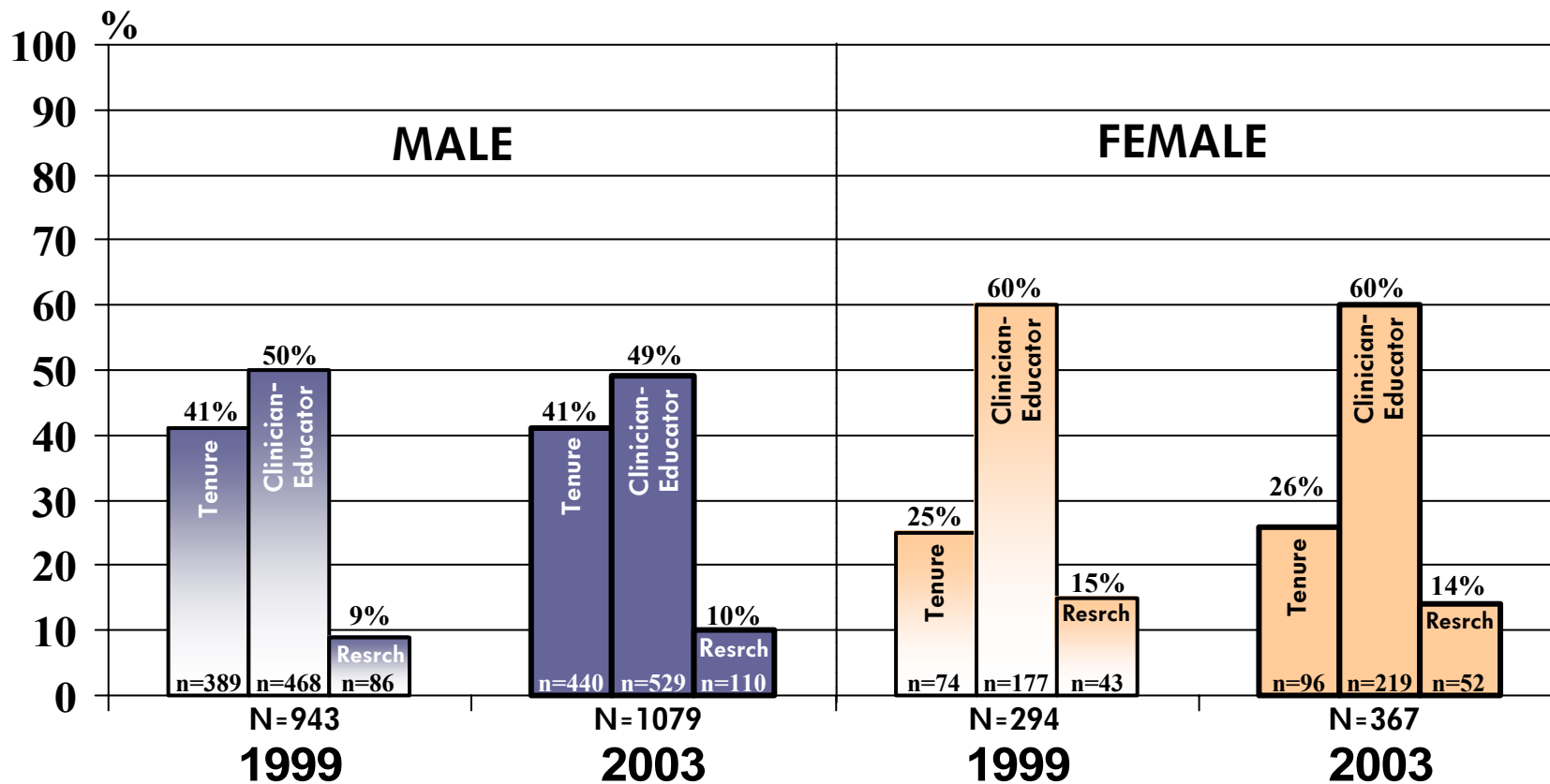

Distribution of Tracks Separated by Gender

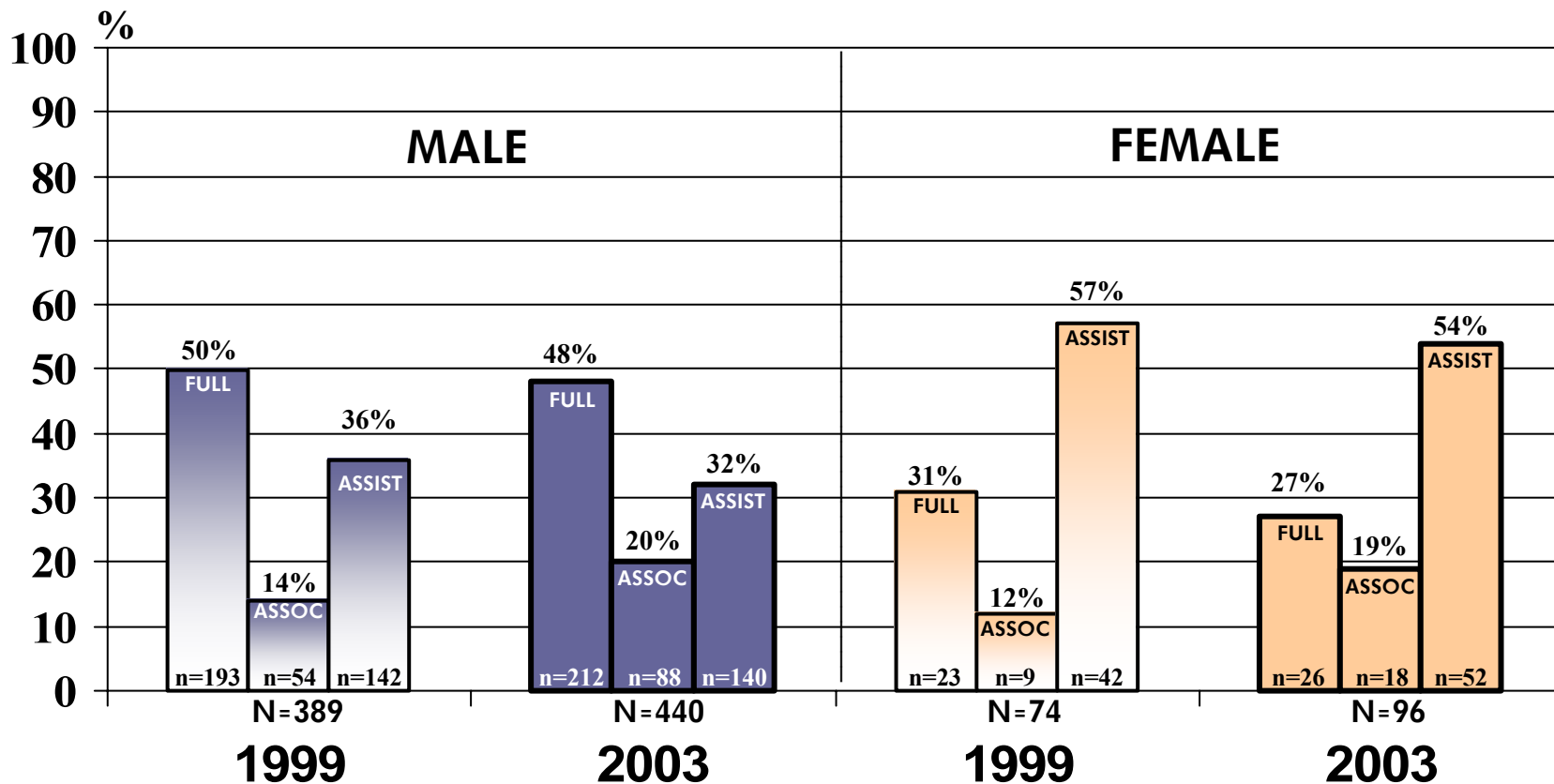

Rank Distribution of *Tenure* Track, by Gender

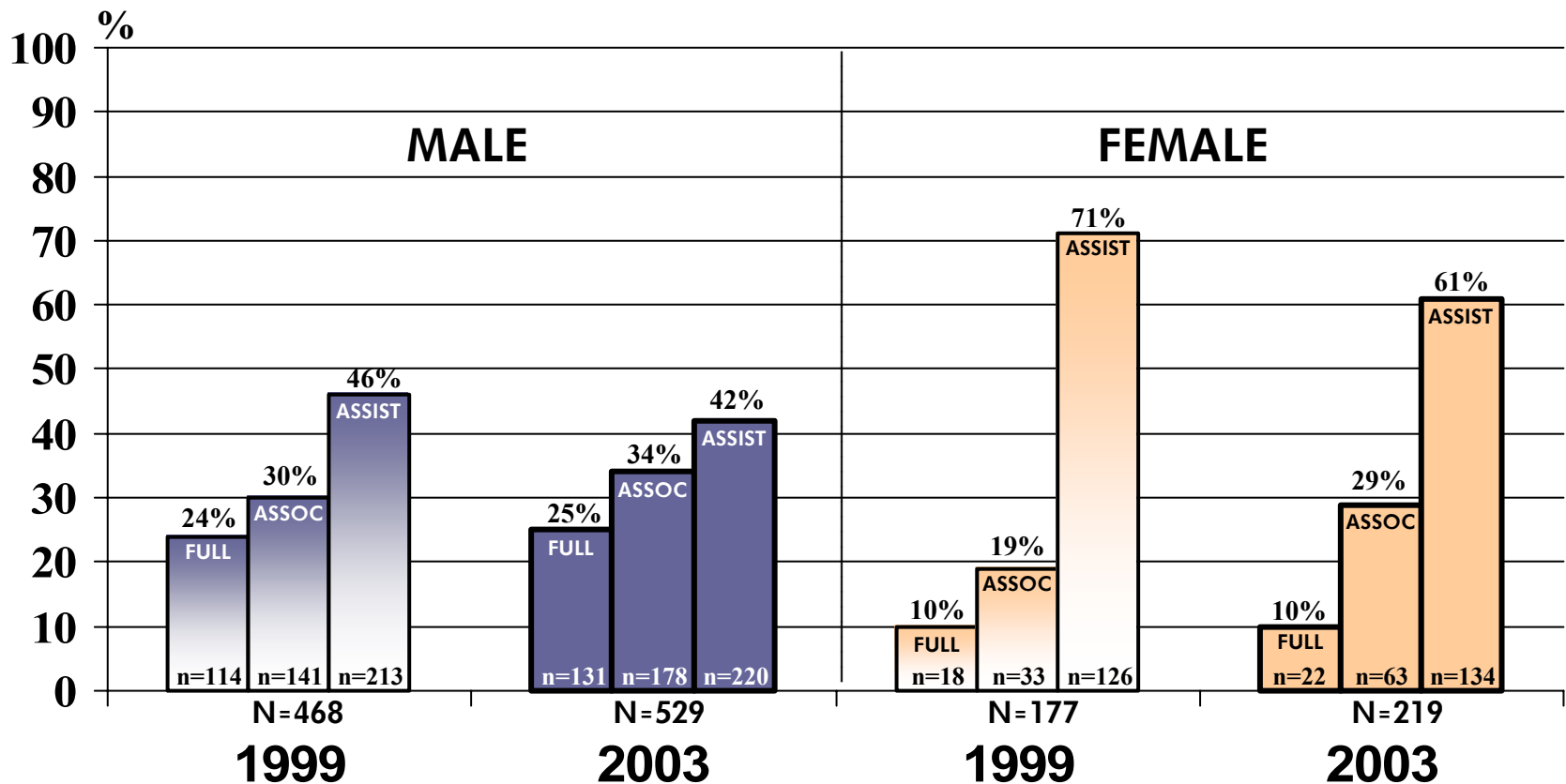

Rank Distribution of *Clinician-Educator* Track, by Gender

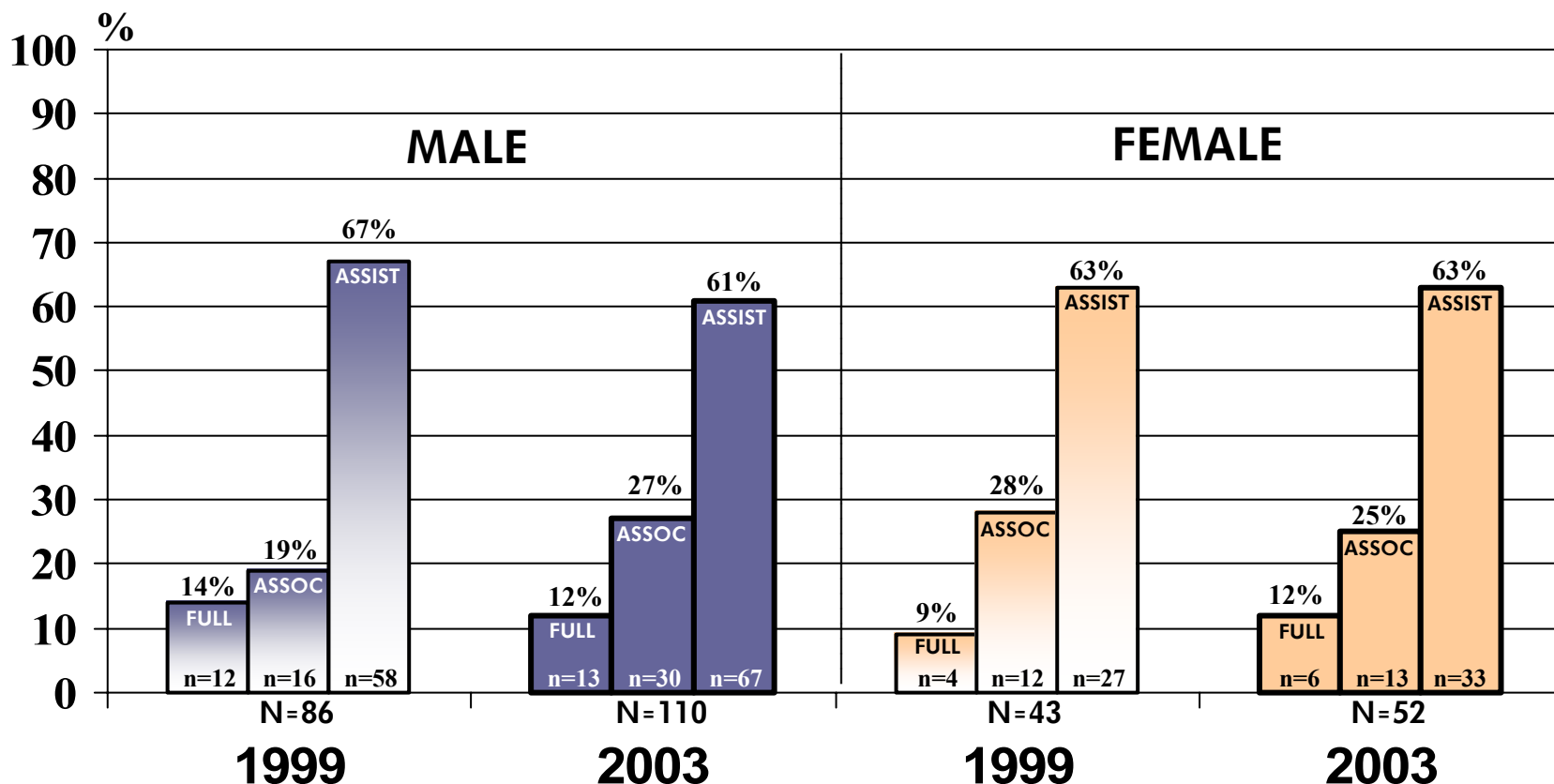

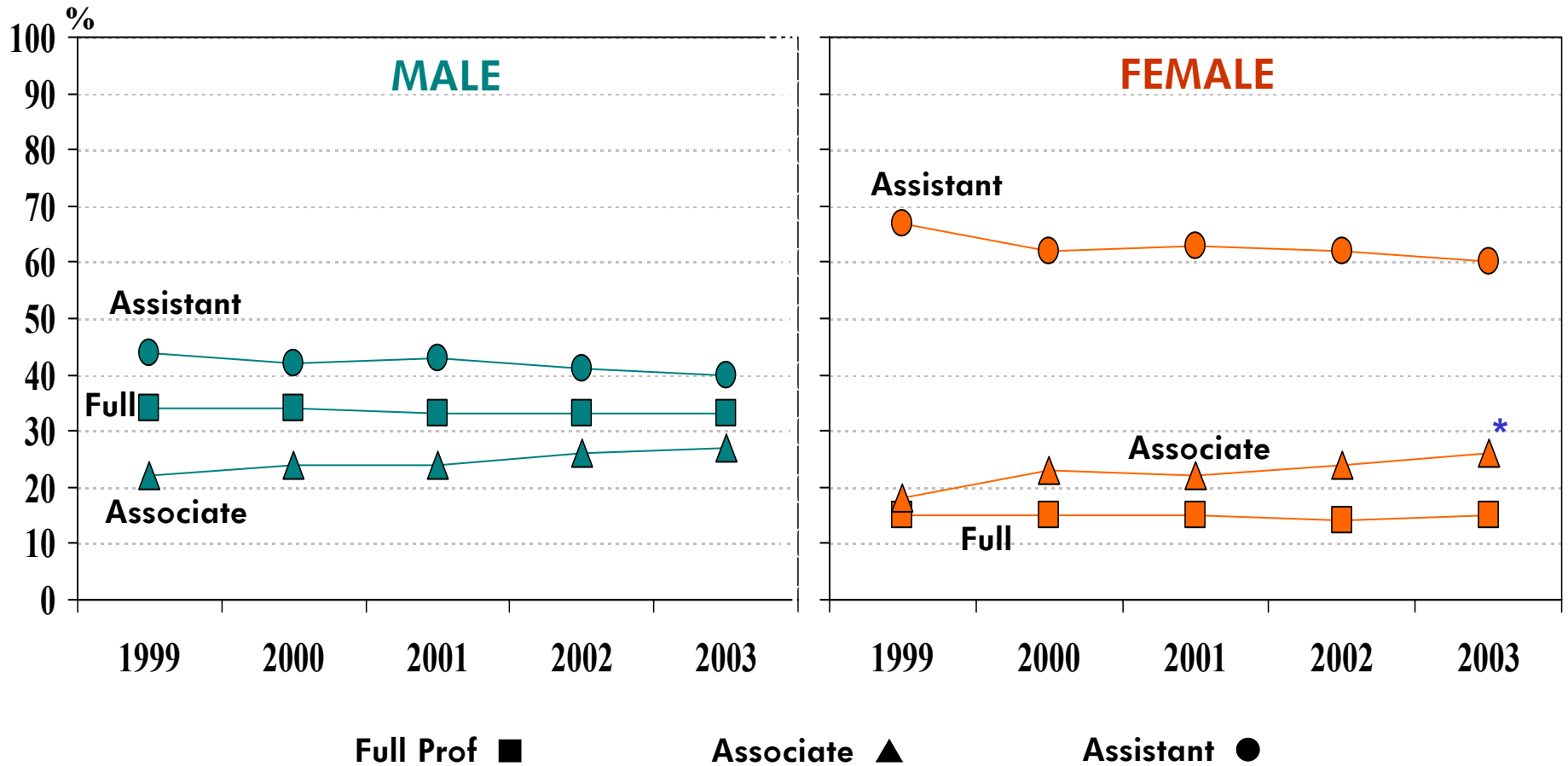

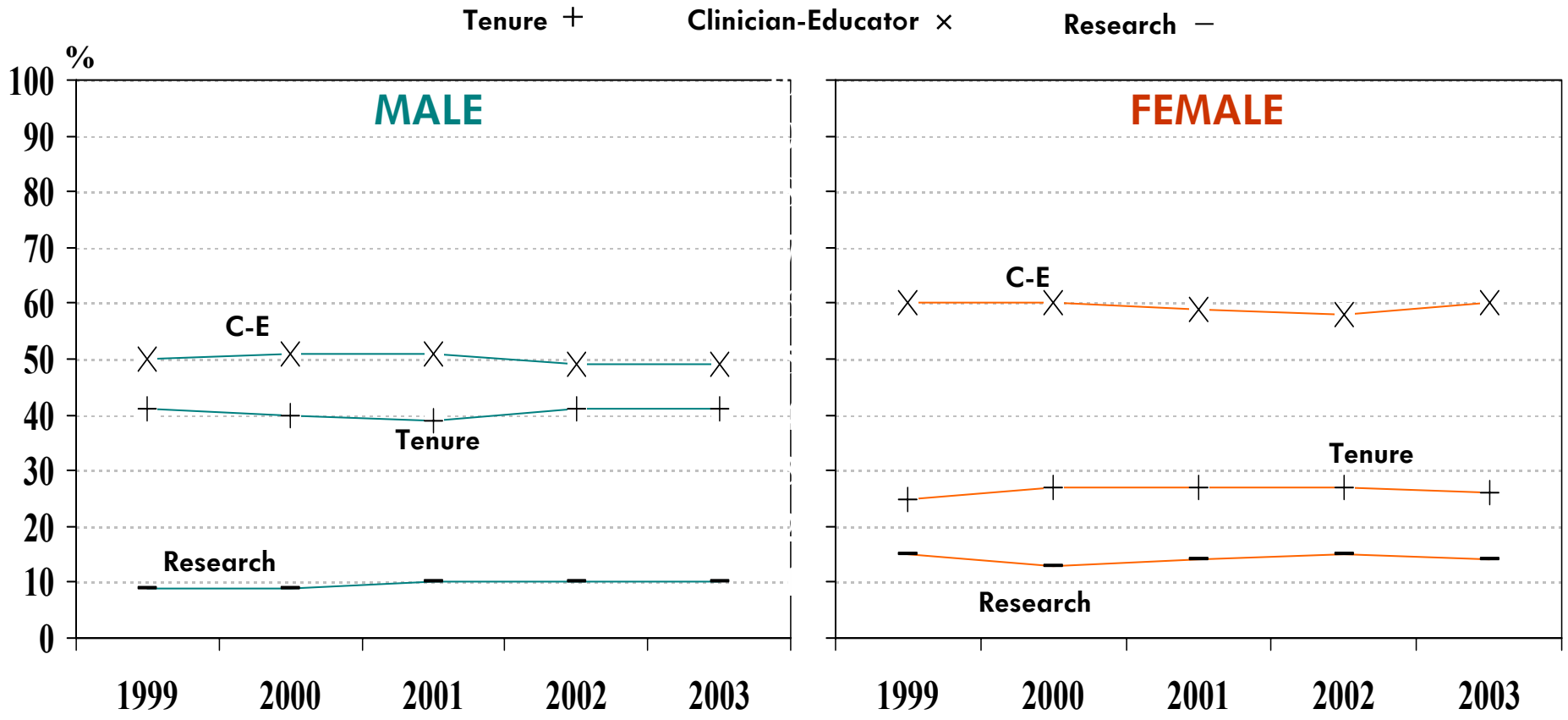

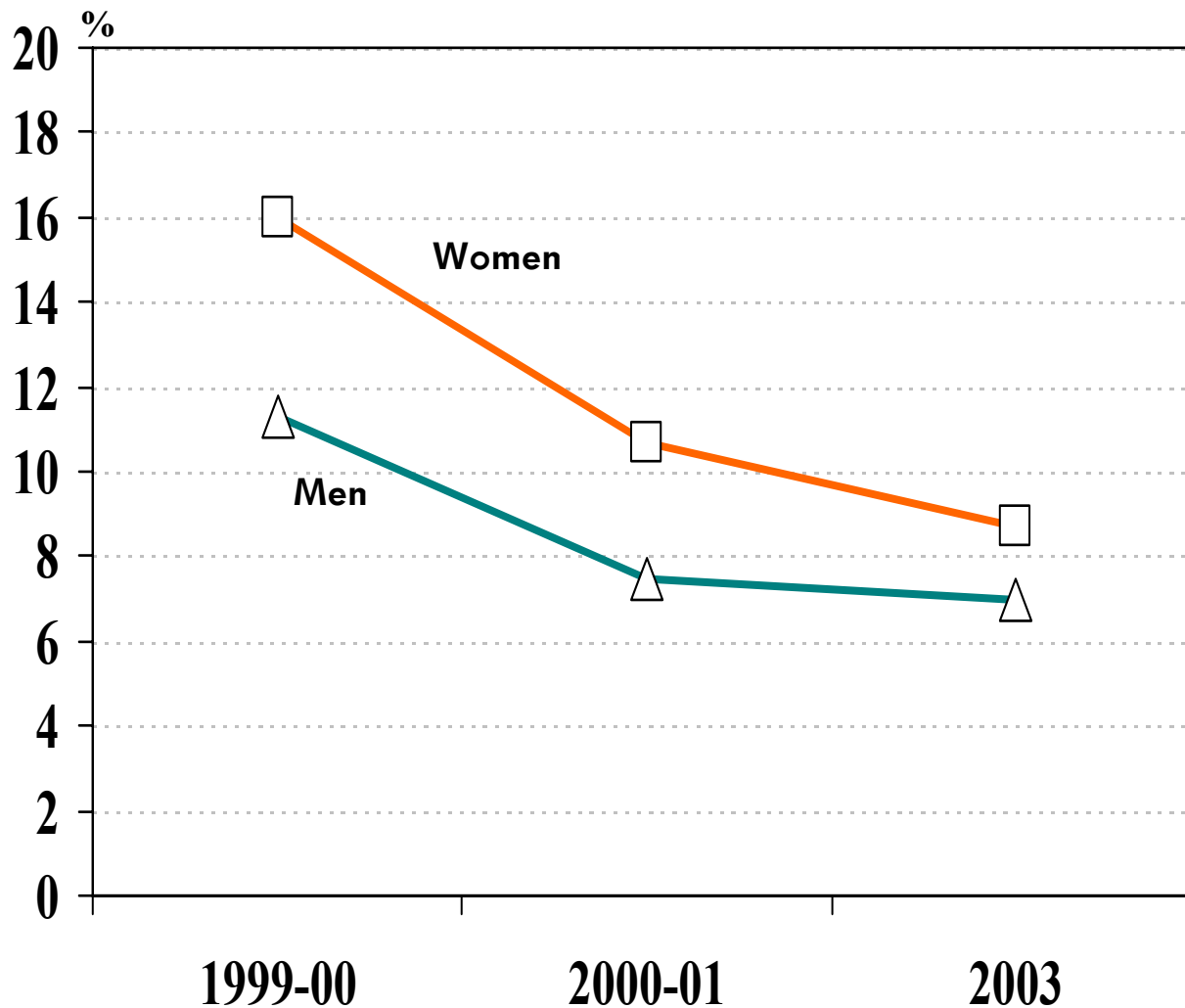
