CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

The Thomas B. McCabe and Jeannette E. Laws McCabe Fund was established in 1969 by a generous gift from Mr. and Mrs. Thomas B. McCabe to the School of Medicine. The McCabe Fund Advisory Committee, which oversees the award process, welcomes junior faculty (Assistant Professors) appointed between July 1, 2024 and June 30, 2026 to submit proposals that are innovative biomedical and surgical research that bridge the clinical and basic sciences. **This opportunity is open to clinical (CE and AC) track junior faculty with no or limited extramural research funding.** Tenure and research track faculty are not eligible to apply. The McCabe Award process is based in the Department of Surgery in coordination with the Perelman School of Medicine Dean's Office and the University investment office.

McCABE FUND AWARD APPLICATION

Effective this year, the McCabe Fund Award Program will offer a single award type, the McCabe Fund Award, with a funding level of \$50,000 per award.

Departments may submit a maximum of four applications for the McCabe Fund Award. The Department of Medicine may submit up to five applications. If a department has more interested applicants than available submission slots, the department chair will select the most competitive applications to submit to the McCabe Advisory Committee on behalf of the department.

All McCabe Fund Awards are one-time, non-renewable, and non-transferable. Award selections will be made by the McCabe Advisory Committee at its annual meeting in June.
