NIH FUNDING AND F&A COSTS

- Proposal to cap "indirects" at 15%
- **F&A costs pay for the utilities**, infrastructure, regulatory and more
- > NIH F&A do NOT cover the full cost. Universities already covering ~1/2
- > NIH funding is the best ROI for any government spending at 2.4-fold!!
- > In PA \$2.23B is converted to \$5.2B in economic activity and 22,000 jobs
- > Nationally, \$47B from NIH fuels a \$1.55T pharma and biotech industry
- > Essentially ALL new drugs have their origin in science funded by NIH
- > ~1.1-1.3M people employed by pharma/biotech. ~20-30% with PhD or MD
- > We train 8-10,000 PhD and 29,000 MD each year fueling this workforce
- > Privatizing science will make things *more* expensive
- > All voices are important to support the NIH!!!
